In 1877, Mrs. Samuel Tunstall was charged with 400 acres of land, and the balance 208½ acres was charged to Saml Tunstall's Estate. Mrs. Tunstall died in 1892 and left a will in which she left to her nephew William B. Cluverius the property at Little Plymouth.<sup>4</sup>
