 unto the right Honourable the Lord Proprietary in yee  
 and just summe of fiftty pounds Sterling money to be paid  
 to his said lordship his heires and Successours to which pay  
 in full and truly to be made and done the bondes and  
 and other fees and charges and all other expenses Executors  
 and administrators for his heire and in the whole property  
 and chancery for making these presentes had and done  
 shall and do at the twenty third day of February  
 year of his said Lordship's Dominion of Maryland anno 1682.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bond  
 Esther Mundayne Patrick Mullkin and Thomas Brown  
 Planter of Talbot County Planter thereof  
 do well and truly Administer all and Singulare the goods Chattell and
