

Barron of Virginia

Gilbert Barron was born ca 1545 in Lancastershire, England and married on 9/18/1569 in Standish, Lancashire, England, Margery Halliwell.

Their son, Robert Barron, was chr. On 6/16/1592 in Standish, Lancashire, England, and died in James City County, Virginia. He was married on 5/1/1611 in Great Harwood, St. Bartholomews, Lancastershire, England, Isabel Hindley. Robert Barron was the first of the family to emigrate to America. "Robert Barron, age 18, to Virginia in 1635". Original Lists of Persons of Quality, page 106.

Their son, Andrew Barron, was born 1617 in London, England, died in James City County, Virginia. He was married on 2/10/1662 in St. Giles Cripplegate, London, England to Mary Ewens, a daughter of William Ewens, Mariner and his wife, Margaret (Clement) Ewens. Andrew's name was listed on the ships manifest "David., John Hogg, Master in 1635. (Hotten, p. 129). On 4/21/1695 Capt. John Stythe was granted 595 acres in James City County for transporting 12 persons, included Andrew Barron.

Their daughter, Catherine Barron, born 1672 in James City County, Virginia, died 1715 in King and Queen County, Virginia, married 1689 in James City County, Thomas Campe, the son of Thomas Campe and Sarah (Williamson) Camp.
