Captain Francis Slaughter (1630–1656) was the son of John (above), Captain of the Militia, Justice for Rappahannock County, Virginia, married Elizabeth Underwood in 1652, the daughter of Colonel William Underwood and his wife, Margaret.

Francis Slaughter, planter, the son of Captain Francis Slaughter, was born 1653 in Essex County, Virginia and died 1718 in Richmond County, Virginia. He was married to Margaret Hudson in 1679. Issue:

- Robert Slaughter, born 1680, died 1726, planter of Essex County, Virginia where he died. He
 was married in 1700 to Frances Ann Jones, the daughter of Lit. Colonel Cadwallader and
 Katherine Jones of Stafford County, Virginia. Issue.
 - 1. Francis Slaughter, born 1701 in Essex County, Virginia, died 1766 in Culpeper County. He was Captain of the Militia, later Colonel; Justice; Vestryman and Church Warden. He was married on 6/3/1729 to Ann Lightfoot of Spotsylvania County, Virginia, a daughter of Major Goodrich and Mary (Chew) Lightfoot. Issue:

 - c. Reuben Slaughter, Revolutionary War Soldier, was born 1733 in Culpeper County, Virginia, married Betty Poindexter.
