 Tract or parcel of Land containing One hundred and forty three Acres lying and
 being in the County of Prince George on the north side of Rottenway River ~
 and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at his own the corner above

Oak on the River James along his own side line north ten degrees west two hundred and forty one poles
 to his corner Stirrings thence east two hundred and eighteen poles along John High Line to Hardaway's
 corner thence along Hardaway's line south fifteen degrees west ninety seven poles to his corner
 thence west ten degrees north one hundred poles to his corner thence south ten degrees west one
