

In the Name of God Omnipotent. August 15th 1673.

I John Hawes of the upper part of the County of Northampton
being att present thankfull to god in perfect health and
memorye do make this my last will and Testament as follows
I give and bequeath my soule into the hands of almighty
god my creater & of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ my
Redemer in certeintie assured hope of a joyfull resurrec-
tion at the last day and my body I commit to the earth
to christians to decent buriall and after my just debts
satisfied I give and bequeath my worldly Estate both
house and psonall I give & bequeath as followeth.

I give and bequeath unto my eldest Sonn John Hawes
the Plantacion I now live on friendly belonginge to
William Shewell beginninge at the Branch that doth
the land of our deare Richard Kellam and extendinge to
the next Branch Eastward that doth by the said I now
live on and the land bought by me of Nath Rader
and extending from the head of the said branch by
a direct line unto the land held by me and our
fellowes. my will is that my said Son John Hawes
shall have the management of my said Plantacion with all the houses
hencing & thence belonginge when he shall attaine
the age of eighteen years wch said Plantacion I give
unto my said Son John Hawes to him & his heires for
ever. alwayes provided that my beloved wife Rosalie
Hawes shall have the management of the said plantacion
whilst my said Son shall attaine the age of eighteen
years and in case my wife shall remaine a widow
my will is that my said wife shall still have
the said Plantacion duringe that she shall remaine a widow
standinge my said Son shall have the management
of the said Plantacion.

I give and bequeath unto my said Son John Hawes
my wifes Suit of clothes with a Cambric waist and
best lace and pair of new worsted stockings and a new
Holland shirt.

I give and bequeath unto my said Son John Hawes
one featherbed bought by me of Mr John Shopward
boulter pair of Sheets to Rugg, 1 pair of Blankets one
pair of Darny Curtains & Bedding.

I give and bequeath unto my said Son John Hawes
one Copper Kettle with a round dish bottom and the
biggest iron pot and two powder dishes one iron pan
and Gunn that is commonly used by Williams Peaford and
my Ranger all to be delivered when her shall attaine
the age of 21.

I give and bequeath unto my said Son John Hawes

100. my Great Gettys called by the name of Pomoy Grey w^t
my best credit and bidding to be delivered him to his said
Saidly after my death but not to sue or dispose of until
he attains ye age of eightye years alwayes provided
that if in case my wife Rodrik Hawes shall have occasion
to make use of the said Gettys then my will is that
shee be not denied the use thereof w^tch said Gettys
giv^e unto my said Sonn to him and his heires for ever
I give and bequeath unto my said Son John Frankel all
the Plankes that is laid layd in any of the buildings of
my Plantacion but rememb^r out of the said buildings
but furthor my will is that my Saynges have at much
two inch wide plankes to lyg^e by as will flear the
Carr^t when occasion requires and that my said son
John Hawes have at much Jack and quarter plankes of
which is already laved at will flear the Dwellinge
house I now live in and my will is that my said dwelling
house be now now pulled and flearred and repaired by
my said son in Consideration hereof and furthor my will
is that if in case my said Son John Hawes shoud depart
this life before he shall attaine to age or have if not
lawfully begonne then my will is that my son William
Hawes shall his puppe when he shall attaine the
age of eightye years provided hee be with the
plantacion given by me to my son John Hawes
and with all things else to my said son John according
to the tenures at before written.

101. I give and bequeath unto my said son John Hawes
my great Dutch chst and a Table now standinge in
my Dwellinge house to be delivered him when he shall
attaine to age and that the said John Hawes be
remained with his mother until hee come to age.

102. I give unto my said son William Hawes that pice
of land boyned the hulfe of five hundred acres purchased
by me and Dernan Sollivan of Nathaniell Bradf^t
and delivred by Souldy by Consett Compt^t at 250 acres
the said tract of land to begin on the Eastward side
of the Branch to the Eastward of my Dwellinge house
and extendinge to the line of marked trees w^tch doo^rd of the
land of Dernan Sollivan and more with what more land
may bee left at the head of the said land in the woods
taken by me to the line of marked trees that delivred
the land sold by me to our Collevoy w^tch land fell
of land I give unto my Son William Hawes with all the
fringe,

10. My Will is that my Son William have & his Rents for ever
fence and all other appurtenances thereto belonginge
to him my said William have & his Rents for ever /
I give and bequeath to my Son William Haworth all
my wearinge clothes Except them I have given before
and further bid that byes in the Tenement bed stowd in
the outwards chamber out bouldre one p[er]c of shooles
1 p[er]c of Blanketts 1 Rugg 2 powder dishes 1 Jar
pott 1 chust 1 Gunn that was his Grandfathers all
to be delivered unto my said Son William when he
shall attaine the age of Eightyone yeards /
11. I give and bequeath unto my Son William Haworth
one Black Girding called by the Name of Blackbuck
beinge bounded with my owne Brans with my old
breeds & saddle to be delivered him immediately after
my Decease to him but not to sale or dispose of but it
had attaine the age. But if in case his mother had
occasion to make use of the said Girding then my
will is that shee be not denysed therof wch said
Girding I give unto my said Son William to him and
his Rents for ever —
12. My will is that in case my Son William Haworth shall
depart this life before he attaine the age of Eightyone
yeards or shoule die without fynd lawfully legatess
then my will is that my son Charles Haworth in case
hee be livinge shall haue yee plantation given to
me to my Son William Haworth and all things appur-
taininge to my said Son William when he
shall attaine the age of Eightyone yeards wch said
and all thinges appurtenant thereto I give unto my said Son Charles
Haworth to him and his Rents for ever to be yee
according as before written.
13. I give unto my Son Charles Haworth and to my Son
Thomas Haworth one branch of land bought by me
of John Cropper commonly called by the Name of
James Works lyinge at the head of Ciacahambecke —
crooked toward the dale computed to 245 acres which
said parcell of Land my will is to be equally divided
by a line of marked trees a croft wch works fein
branch to branch and that my Son Charles Haworth
haue and bee possesse wth that halfe next the Croft
when hee shall attaine the age of Eightyone yeards
and my Son Thomas Haworth haue yee other halfe
at the head of the Works and bee possesse therof when
hee shall attaine the same age and also my will
is that my Son Thomas Haworth haue fees & charges

24. To give to the feildings all ale hirsts that have may -
 halv-occupacion to godhird to which said 245 acres of
 land I give to my son charles & thomas Hawarde to
 them and their heirs for ever. But in case either of my
 said sons charles or thomas Hawarde shalldyng without
 due lawfully by reason then my will is that my son
 william Hawarde bor possitt with the said tract of land
 called by the name of Jamys Arches and my daughter
 John Hawarde to my selfe and possesse the whole 735. —
 acres of land which now lieth on. —

15. I give and bequeath unto my son charles Hawarde one
 featherbed now lyng in an high bedstead in the out-
 ward chamber of my Roud with a Bulster 1 pte of
 sheets 1 pte of Blanketes and a Rugg one from pote
 2 powder dishes and chest the bigger of the two small
 gumm all to bee delivred him when he shall attaine
 the age of eighteene yeare. —

16. I give and bequeath unto my son thomas Hawarde one
 featherbed, bulster 1 pte of sheets 1 pte of Blanketes a
 Rugg one from pote 2 powder dishes and chest one small
 gumm which my will is bee paymed for him out of
 the produce of my servants labours and to be delivred
 him when he shall attaine to age of eighteene yeare. —

17. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Hawarde
 one large new featherbed bulster 1 pte of sheets 1 pte
 of Blanketes and Rugg one new suit of bed curtains
 and beddens the best now standing in my junior
 chamber one from pote 3 powder dishes 6 powder plates
 and silver back cup all to bee delivred her at sixteen
 yeare of age. —

17. Then I give and bequeath unto my said daughter Elizabeth
 Hawarde one ewe Lamb and yearlinge Ram and
 mare colt of the breed incroft of the Somer mare
 called sib with all the future increase for yo pte.
 And of my daughter Elizabeth Hawarde and also my
 will is that shoo haue her part both of Poynt and
 cattle and sheep delivred her when shoo shall attaine
 the age of sixteene yeare out of the greatest stocke
 which mare colt ewe Lamb and yearlinge Ram
 give unto my daughter Elizabeth Hawarde to her and
 her heirs for ever. —

28. My will is that all my herfor except what I haue dyned
 before or what I shall give unto my wife hereafter
 named shall bring two younge shundreys and Gredinge

Feb 11. Two mards and yonglinge mard all called & Shew so.
But what I have givd & my wfe to my wife is that they
dwine on my Plantacion and her to wortell her whiche
my sonn John Hawstet attane to yo age twenty years
and then too he had his part both of hysf & cattell
mards & shewes to merte him yest & still shal a rumour
on my Plantacion betwle all my sons and my daugher
Elizabeth to age as afor. And also thon ondry one to
have their part as they attane to age delivred them
which I freely give amvng my said children to them
and their heire for ever. alwayes probate it bee
understood that my said sonn John Hawstet bee at
age att eighteene years to bee profest and enjoy what
I have givdn him as before Expressid.

19. They
I give and bequeth unto my wife Roderah Hawstet
one Grtinger called by the name of Jacke and one
sonde mard called by yo Name of Libb. all her
future incroas except her second mard call which
is for her daughter Elizabeth Hawstet as is aformentoone
I give also unto my wife six Ewes and one Ram 3 Cows
and cubbs and that all the male kind of cattle and
sheeps But what is for the necessary pribision of the
house. hysf or Grtinger bee at the dispotall of my
wife and thos plens hereafter named 3 men and 2
woman serb to ward the Education and bee of my
children. I give unto my wife Roderah Hawstet one
Houlsheire and boulshre 1 pds of Blankedas and Rugg.
one pds of sheetts and curtainis and valance of Draper
and all the rest of the householde good. But what
have given to my children I make my wife Roderah
Hawstet my sole Executrix of this my last will &
testamant. And Mr Thomas Ducke and Mr Southy
Littleton to bee assistants to the aforesaid Roderah
Hawstet my wife.
