 Tobacco and fashions in hand paid & satisfied fast as of Andrew Steward of the
 County of Montgomery sauer stand bargained claimed sold confirmed assigned and delivered unto
 as y^e said presents of good bargain & value for y^e said assigned and delivered to the said Andrew
 Steward three hundred and fifty acres of land situate lying and being on Occoromocke River in
 the County of elcomacke & bounded as follows: to wit: the said three hundred and fifty
 acres beginning on the Eastward side of y^e River to y^e Eastward of my said fathers dwelling
 house & extending to a line of marked trees w^{ch} divides the said land from y^e land of Denton
 Sullyant y^e other hundred acres lying in y^e woods at the head of y^e said land running to a
 line of marked trees that divides it from y^e land sold by my said father to Owen Bowman
 of the same and to hold y^e said three hundred & fifty acres of land w^{ch} all houses & edifices buildings
 ournments gardenes fowles pastures woods & whatsoever interest maner water watercourses
 and other appurtenances whatsoever therunto belonging or in any way appertaining
 to him the said Andrew Steward his heirs and assigns from the day of y^e date hereof
 for ever: so that neither the said William ffawcett nor his heirs Executors or
