 direct his Govern<sup>r</sup> and Council for his said coming to make and pass  
 in y<sup>e</sup> said County and Planters of his his maj<sup>ty</sup> Dominion Black  
 Lands of said y<sup>e</sup> condition of y<sup>e</sup> said and paying unto his ma<sup>ty</sup>  
 his heirs and Success<sup>rs</sup> a certain annual Rent as in y<sup>e</sup> Grants and  
 Patents is expressed w<sup>ch</sup> y<sup>e</sup> intent may be duly collected and  
 paid for his maj<sup>ty</sup> use I Grantis Lord Howard Baron of Effingham  
 his Maj<sup>ty</sup> and Govern<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> of Vir<sup>g</sup> do in his maj<sup>ty</sup> name

 Patents doo<sup>g</sup> and Tenoyants by w<sup>ch</sup> y<sup>e</sup> respective Inhab<sup>ts</sup> doo<sup>g</sup> hold
