So all Christian People to whom these presents shall come I Thomas James of London Mariner, send greeting, know ye that I said Thomas James for Divers good Causes & Considerations, out of my own moving have made and made constitute and appointed and do by these presents and in my place & stead make ordain constitute & appoint my Dear & Loving sons I warrant, and my trust & lawful attorney, Educable for me and in my name to seek sue for recover & receive of any person or persons whatsoever in the Colony of Virginia or beyond that are now indebted or shall be unto me the said Thomas James or his Obligations or otherwise & Acquittances & other Lawful Discharges for me in my name to sign, seal & deliver and further said said Thomas James do by these presents give & grant Liberty to my above named attorney to sell and Dispose off any part of my Estate now in the Colony of Virginia and I do hereby ratify & Confirm whatsoever my said Attorney shall do or Lawfully shall to be done in my name as fully in every respect as I might or could do: if I was personally present and to this Letter of Attorney I have set my hand and affixed my seal this 28th Day of Sept. Anno Domini 1685
