I give & bequeath unto Amy the Daughter of Robert Comper
Mason that Feather bed & furniture & it belonging that Harroth
in the outward Room. I also give her one thousand of the to be
paid in Schooling

I give & bequeath unto Elizabeth Mason the Daughter of the sd
Robert Comper one Cows and Calves & to Comperance I give
Cows and Calves

I give & bequeath unto William Nock my Nephew & one
Feather bed & furniture being that in my Chamber and unto his
son William I give two Cows & Calves: and unto his son William
I give two Cows & Calves and unto John the Son of the sd William
& Bationed Nock I give & bequeath one Cow & Calf

I give & bequeath unto Richard Saywell the value of one
thousand Pounds of Tob. in such things as may be useful for him

I give & bequeath unto Jane Parson one Cows & Calves
hundred pounds of Tob. & Cows & Calves her wages w^{ch} if she should
be next October will be five hundred more but 500 in all

till as my stock can best afford

sonward the value of one thousand p^{ts} of t^l at the time of
his freedom when he p^{re}ies; all these Legacies if effects sufficient

to pay all my forementioned Legacies after ffairall expences &
other just p^{re}ments that then each Legation shall according
to the proportion of their severall Legacies abate of what is hereby
intended to be given In witness of this my last & absolute
Will & Testament I doe hereunto fix my hand & seal this
fourth day of Aprill In the ward of our Lord God one thousand
six hundred & twenty eight

that my above named Executor should raise one thousand pounds
out of some part of my estate & the same bestow or lay
