Item - Being sorry from y<sup>e</sup> bottom of my heart for all my sinnes Hoping to have forgiveness & Pardon for the same I bequeath my soule to Almighty God that gave it me and my Body to the Earth from whence it came to be disposed of in such & such way of Buriall as my Executors hereafter named shall thinke requisite & necessary - Hoping at y<sup>e</sup> Resurrection it will rise again in glory

Item - When it shall please God to take me from this life I give & bequeath unto my God-child Charles White son of W<sup>m</sup> White one Cow & like all their increase to William Dmd son of W<sup>m</sup> Dmd deceased with dole & w<sup>th</sup> in seven days after my death & that my Executors will endeavour to performe y<sup>e</sup> sd service w<sup>th</sup> their increase unto the sd Charles

Item - After all my just debts are paid all y<sup>e</sup> remainder of my estate bequeath unto my Co. friend Capt. Edmund Scarborough & doe likewise my last will & Testament Capt. Scarborough to be Executor of this former will & Testament & making void & null all writ<sup>ts</sup> whereof & other y<sup>e</sup> Statute I have heretofore sett my hand & seal this 10<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> 1680

 and doe by thes p<sup>r</sup>esent Bargain Alien sold and Conferred into John  
 being in Great Matomkin containing about five hundred Acres of Land  
 bounded Southerly by the Land of John Bagwell Northerly by affocks  
 of great Matomkin Creek and a line of marked trees running between  
 the Land of John Tye and the Land of Lieut. John West and the said  
 Bargained Land being part of a greater Parcel of Land (viz) two  
 thousand five hundred & fifty acres Granted unto Ambrose White  
 fifth day of March anno Domi. one thousand six hundred Seventy  
 and two and by the said Ambrose White sold and conveyed to me  
 the said Richard Baile as by Inveyant bearing date the sixteenth day  
 of June anno Domi. one thousand six hundred Seventy & three and  
 now upon Record in Accomack County may & doth at large appeare  
 And to the said the said Bargained Land being about five hundred  
 with all the due share of all mines and minerals therein contained  
 with all Priviledges of Hunting Hawking Fishing & fowling with  
 all wood Pasture & Rivers with all other commodities & hereditaments to  
 the said belonging in as full & ample manner as in the said Grand  
 Patent Granted unto the said Ambrose White deceased expressed together  
 with all my right title and interest according as it was conveyed to  
 me the said Richard Baile by the said Ambrose White unto him the  
 said John the said his heirs & assigns or assigns for ever to his & theirs  
 the use & behoof of his heirs & assigns without any condition or power of Reversion  
 in any wise so that neither the said Richard Baile my heirs & assigns  
 or assigns nor any other from or thence for us or in our names or  
 Challenge or demand in or by the said Baile or any part or parcel  
 thereof any interest Right title use or Possession But from all actions  
 we and every of us be utterly excluded and forever barred by  
 thes p<sup>r</sup>esent the said John the said his heirs & assigns or assigns  
 assigns paying or causing to be paid and discharged the Kings  
 Rents and all other Taxes and Impositions that shall or may  
 be laid on the said Land I witness whereof and also the said Baile
