I will and desire that all my Debts whatsoever be fully satisfied I make constitute & ordain my son George Tuit my sole heir of all my lands Tenements & Hereditaments together wth two cows known by the name of white fool and blacke cow wth the former I entreat for ever and to remaine wth his Mother Eliz. Tuit till he cometh to y^e age of 21 years in case she remaine to long a widow otherwise to remaine untill he arriveth at the age of eighteen & no longer, but in case the said George Tuit dyeth before he arriveth at the age aforesaid that you considering my wifes present condition in case of her happy delivery whether son or daughter I do give and bequeath all the aforesaid Goods Lands Tenements or Hereditaments to him or her or their heirs & assigns for ever and in default of such issue y^e said to fall into the hands of my wife Elizabeth Tuit during her naturall life and after her decease upon the death of him otherwise unto my only son George Tuit aforesaid his heirs for ever

I give and bequeath one Cow and yearling Heifer wth the former I entreat for ever unto that Child that shall be borne by my wife in case she liveth

I make constitute and ordain my deare & well beloved Wife Elizabeth Tuit sole executrix of all my Estate what soever moveable or immoveable except as before expressed and that I do declare publish and ordain as my last Will and Testament revoking and disannulling a l^l other Will

be done in and about and for the recovery of the said summs
to my said use and behoof as aforesaid: And that in so full
and large a manner to all intents purposes and constructions
as my self might or would doo if personally present to be
by sight, arrest, imploring, condemning, imprisoning, or
out of Prison delivring; or by giving good and sufficient
discharge and acquittance firm in Law & sworn witness of
the premises or any part or parts thereof or by substituting
out or more Attorney or Attorneys under him: and the same again
revoking or otherwise Ratifying allowing and holding hereby
Him and Heirs, all that and whatsoever else my said
