In the name of God amen January 1st 1889 I John
 show being sick and weak out of sound and perfect memory
 thanks to the God and knowing uncertainty of this life
 desire to settle that small Estate which God hath given me
 do make this my last will and Testament renouncing all other
 will by me formerly made allowing and ratifying this to stand
 in full force and virtue as my last will and Testament this I
 give and bequeath my Soul into the hands of a mighty God
 my heavenly Father in due and certain hope of eternal Salvation
 through His mercy and merits of Jesus Christ my alone Saviour
 and Redeemer and my body to be decently laid in my grave in
 such decent manner as shall seem meet and convenient as to
 my executor hereafter named
 After al my just and lawful debts be fully paid and satisfied
 my will and desire is that what small Estate God in mercy hath
 sent me be given and impayed as is hereafter expressed
 Item my will is that all my Creatures of what kind soever shall remain
 upon my Plantation for the full term of four years and then
 to be divided as followeth
 Item to my Son John one Cow and Calf with all their increase to him
 and his heirs and to my Son Thomas one Cow and Calf to him
 and his heirs also to my Son Henry one Cow and Calf to him
 and his heirs and what creatures of what kind
 soever shall be born to him being or can be young that all of
 my Estate my will is that they be equally divided to every of
 all my Sons and Daughters at equal share
 And my will is that all my household Goods that shall come
 coming at the end of the four years as is aforesaid shall be
 then equally divided between my three Sons
 and for my Seat of Land being two hundred and fifty acres
 Item I give to my Son John show and his heirs for ever one hundred
 and Eighteen acres of Land lying along the Creek and the
 Branch Item I give to my Son Thomas show and his heirs
 for ever one hundred and sixteen acres lying next to my Son
 John on the Southward side of his 118 Acres I give to my Son
 Henry show and his heirs for ever one hundred and sixteen
 acres lying on the Southern side of my Seat on the land aforesaid
 between my Land and John Lewis
 and I do by this my last Will constitute and appoint James
 Crut as my true and lawful executor that he my Son
 Execut^d with the advice and counsel of Coll^l John West
 and William West shall see to my quiet and peaceable will
 and tranquillity of my Children and regarding them and doing
 of them to use all lawful means to do for my Children

from all unjust dealing of any person and also to direct
to my children their severall shares of goods Cattle and Land
according to the true intent and meaning of this my last Will
and Testament to which I have set my hand and Seal this
10th day of January ann. 1689

I call to whom these presents shall come know ye that Parcus
Elsworth Executor of the last Will & Testament of James
Elcomack deceased for full consideration and satisfaction in
hand received by the said Parcus and his two Covenants and four
have alienated Bargained and confirmed and by their records
Alienated Bargained sold & confirmed to John Prettman of the County
Elcomack Twenty one hundred & forty Acres of Land at a place
Mespango in the County of Elcomack out of the lot of land
by Patent way of Land of John Elsworth deceased beginning at a stake
on 4th March by a Gutt then bounded Southward by a stake
a point westerly 20 poles to woodland ground & then 136 poles to a corner
then South South West half a point westerly 129 poles to
another corner then East South East half a point Southwesterly 120
poles to another corner then North North East 204 poles to a
stake at the gutt then bounded by a gutt unto the full beginning
together with all rights & reversions & remainders & vertues & appurtenances
Immodities Emendments and advantage whatsoever belonging to
the same unto the said John Prettman his heirs Executors
Administrators & assigns for ever so have and to hold & to have
his abovesaid premises promised with all his severall Meads
Meadows feeding pasture & services and hereditaments & all
and singular other the promises, and every the appurtenances
thereto belonging & in any wise appertaining unto the said
John Prettman & to his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns for
ever and to his and their heirs and assigns for ever and to his and their
a absolutely without any Contradiction power or revocation in any
wise so that neither the said Parcus Elsworth my heirs Executors
Administrators or assigns nor any other person or persons for me or
in my name or in the name or names of us at any time or times
shall or may Ask Challenge or Demand or to any person or persons
or any part thereof or any Interest in the premises or to any person or persons
actions of right title Claims use possession and every of us to be
utterly excluded & for ever declared by their persons and further
the said Parcus Elsworth doe Give my full power full authority
Admin^r and assigns to all the abovesaid premises with every the
appurtenances unto the said John Prettman his heirs Executors
Admin^r or assigns or to any person or persons or to any person or persons
