for ever after I give unto my son y^e best feather bed and furniture in my house
with Roug and Blankets belonging to it my will is that my son sh^{all} serve
at Southtons years to labor for himself but that to make bargaine and
conferme any bargaine w^{ch} he sh^{all} consent of his mother if she be alive
with untill he attains to y^e age of twenty years I likewise give unto my
son two Shirts w^{ch} I am now possesse of I likewise give unto my
years old mare at my house & her mares and a new saddle and bridle to him &
his naturall heirs for ever I likewise give him my small Gun and three
powder dishes and one Iron pott containing full gallons and one hand mill
and likewise a Equall proportion of y^e Cattle w^{ch} his mother and his sons to
seventeen years of age then to be sold with his mother and his sons to
and whatsoever w^{ch} I shall in this my last will and testament of my Estate
bequeath unto my son I also give my son all my wearing habits after
my death I also give my servant woman named Eliza one Cow & her
milk at the day of her freedom

Imp. I give unto my daughter Mary white three Cowes and three Sows to
her & her naturall heirs for ever to be divided to her after my death
with Cows is this named Rags & Motey & Berry likewise I give to my
daughter Mary one feather bed and bolster with one Roggs and Blankets and three
poker dishes with them the same now in my life time & one full good
Iron pot containing four Gallons and one pot containing one full good
daughter Mary to have and all fifteen years old and then to be sold w^{ch} I
shall give him and that my last will and testament of my Estate

Item - I give and bequeath I make constitute & ordain & appoint my dear and
well beloved wife Sarah White to be execut^r of this my last will and
testament to whom I bequeath all the Remainder of my good and
chattels moveables and immovables after the satisfaction of my
debts and payment of the Legacies above by me bequeathed to her and
tuiton after y^e end of all my children and I do hereby nominate &
appoint my well beloved friend Mr. Johnson & Thomas Barrimore
overseers to see that my last will & testament be duly performed in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal of years above written
