Grants all my Estate Right title Interest Power right & title of Power release or demand whatsoever which I now have or had or by any way or means hereafter may or can have of and in a certain tract of land bounded on the head of a Brook in the County aforesaid and containing one hundred and eighty acres wth all and singular the appurtenances of in or to any part or parts thereof at the same it more fully expressed in a certain deed of Indemnity bearing Equall date wth these presents made by me Richard Holland to the said Henry Sellman to the said Francis Holland nor any claiming from or under shall or may at any time or times hereafter Claim challenge or demand any Estate Right title interest Power title of Power or thing at common Law But off and from all & all manner of action of Power Right title or interest shall and will be excluded and forever barred by these presents In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this sixteenth day of April Ann^o.
