 my daughter Mary my will is that she shall be at age at fifteen yea old

In the name of God Amen this 5th day of October 1673 in y^e thirty fifth year
 of his Majesty our Sovereign Lord Charles y^e second by y^e grace of God King of
 England Scotland France and Ireland know y^e that I William Long of y^e
 County of Albemarle in y^e Colony of Virginia being sick and weak in body
 but of sound and perfect memory pray be given to God for y^e same and
 knowing y^e uncertainty of this life on earth and being desirous to settle
 things in order do make this my last will and testament in manner & form
 following that is to say first principally I commend my soul to Almighty
 God my Father & surely believing I shall receive full pardon and full
 remission of my sins and be saved by y^e precious death & merits of my
 blessed Saviour and Redeemer Jesus Christ and my body to y^e earth from
 whence it was taken to be buried in such decent and Christian manner as to
 my exequits hereafter named shall be thought meet and convenient and
 touching such worldly estate y^e Lord in mercy hath lent me I do order
 give and dispose y^e same in manner and form following y^e is to say
 first I will that all my debts and duties as I owe in Right or Prudence
 to any manner of person or persons whover shall be due and due intended and paid
 or ordered to be paid wthin convenient time after my decess first of remitting
 my lands hundred acres of land at Saml Marys in Somerset County in Virg^a
 previous of Mary Land my desire is that my Loving Wife Elizabeth Long do sell
 and equally divide the produce of it between William Long Elizabeth Long &
 my Loving wife Elizabeth

Monday I do give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Long third
 part a full rated bed mattress and a covered spot
 I do give and bequeath unto my son William Long two cows and calves
 and a violet
 I give and bequeath unto my Loving wife Elizabeth Long three cows three goats
 and five geese and one horse called Jack
 I give and bequeath unto my Loving wife Elizabeth Long my mase and my
 children Elizabeth and William Long all y^e rest y^e shall be made shall be
