

This Last Testament of George Johnson is soever written at my ne-
w dwelling house at Muddy Creek on the twentieth Seavenday of
winter month called December in y^e 4th yare of our Lord 1690 And in
the second yare of y^e Raigne of King William and Queen Mary I
Coming not wth in bodie but with out of good and perfect memorie
praises to Almighty God

and first I doe bequeath my Soul to God my maker at what time soever
he shall please to take me and my bodie to y^e earth from whom all
was taken and I be due and acknowledge that y^e way which I now
professe to y^e conship of God is y^e way to life Evernall and I doe
ascribe to him my faith of y^e Son of God whiche is Christ Jesus the life
of y^e world and also for I have earthly things which God hath graced
by giving me I doe will and dispose of them as followeth

2^dly I doe give and bequeath to my Sone Georg Johnson two hundred
acres of Land lying & being y^eppriy wood near to Locksams Bridge
to him and his Lawfull heires for ever

3^dly I doe give and bequeath to my Daughter Sara Stevens a share taken
of my Cove to her and Children now living one young Cow and
to go to be delivered this next spring after my decease

4thly I doe give and bequeath to my Son John Johnson and to his
Lawfull heires for ever my Plantation whereon I now live
that is to say from y^e Gut over which there is y^e horse bridge to
goe over to y^e great marth from thence up y^e Creek and branch
to the extent of y^e said Land allwayes provided that my
said daughter Mary Johnson shall and may have the use of the
said plantation during her widowhood and if she should
Intermarry my will is that my Sone John shall Injoy and
possesse my said plantation when he arrives at y^e age of twenty
one yares

5thly I doe give and bequeath to my Sone Samuell Johnson and to his
Lawfull heires for ever one parcelle of Land and marsh beginning
on y^e further side of y^e Gut where y^e horse bridge is
and so along the said Gut or valley to certliam Nock line and
from y^e said Gut down y^e Creek onto a little Gut lying neare a
Hamock of woods over against Eimothie (as tobacco house wth
a Gut by it on this side of y^e Hamock and from the head of the
Gut direct along the wood side to y^e end of my Pitch that
parteth certliam Nock and me

6thly I doe give and bequeath to my three Sones George John and
Samuell and to their heires for ever one parcelle of marth and
Humocks lying and being on y^e further side of y^e small Gut
before mentioned it being y^e bounds of my Sone Samuels Land
before expressed and from thence y^e said marth to run down
the Creek to the extent of the same which is to a gate and Gut
parting y^e Land of Philip ffisher from mine and from thence
to a ditch parting com Nock and me and so along y^e Pitch
to y^e wood side and end of y^e same

7thly my will and desire is that if any of my three Sons should
die without Lawfull heires or their bodie begotten that their
part of marth given as aforesaid shall be equally divided between

Between y^e Survivors and if any of my sd three Sons be minded
to sell their part of Land or Marthin my will it that he sell
it to on or both of y^e afores^d Brothers at such a price as my
Young friends hereafter named ad overscers of my will
shall thinke fitt

I doo further give and bequeath to my Belov'd wife Mary
Johnson all Servants hogs horses and Sheep of mine y^e shall
be found upon my Plantation or els where at my decess
that shee may by this better enabled and Incouraged to
Interamine flounds /

I doo also give and Bequeath to my Son the third
of all y^e rest of my moveable estate And for y^e other two thirds
of all my moveable estate my will is that it be equally
divided betwixt my five Children viz Georg Swana & Prosser
John and Samuel

It is my will and desire that what former Cattle doth
belong to my son George Offord & Susana John & Samuell
which hath been raised by me though if first of them was
given by others they may and shall have them quietly they
bring no part of what I have given in my will
I doo further will and ann...

I do further will and appoint that all this m^{ts} Catw^y come of the stock of my son John and Samuel shall be for y^e proper use and behoofe of my wife to contribute to her bringing up during their minority

It is my will and desire that my estate be divided as
 of old custom one you after my death as by these whom I
 appoint to be overseers of this my will viz George Stuart
 William Hook Thomas Browne John Drummond and
 Daniel Chyres and in case of death or absence of any of
 them I am to refer to those such honest friends as they shall
 think fit

I do also Constitute and appoint my Loving wife to be my
full and whole Executrix
all which particulars I do confirm with my hand and Seal
this day and year first above written
