Know all men by these presents that I Daniel Jenifer of Accomack County
in Virginia for divers and sundry reasons methought moving to provide
and oblige my self my heirs Executors and Adms unto Margarette and
Nanny my two Indian servants that they the said Margarette & Nanny shall
serve me the said Daniel Jenifer my heirs Executors Adms or assigns
for use longer forme of time to come then six yeares to begin & be computed
from y^e day of y^e date hereof and no longer notwithstanding they were to
serve during their lives at the end of which said six yeares the said Margarette
and Nanny are to be free and at their own disposing and if the said Daniel
Jenifer do further promise to give and deliver unto the said Nanny one
Cott (as) within those 2 months if any of the said Jenifers (overthings
any this yeare if not then y^e next yeare) always provided that is y^e best
Margarette and Nanny doe well & truly discharge their trusts and behave
themselves as faithful servants ought to doe during the aforesaid terme of
six yeares; and whereas I had a boile named Nanny Plathone daughter named
Annis by my negro slave called old Daniel and notwithstanding y^e said
mother will be a free woman at y^e end of six yeares as aforesaid yet the
said daughter Annis is to remane and abide in this service y^e full
said Daniel Jenifer my heirs and assigns until she shall attain
arrive at y^e age of thirty yeares and no longer, yet what children
the said Annis shall have are to remane servants during their and
every of their lives In certnes wherof y^e said Daniel Jenifer
doe hereunto sett my hand & seal this 15th day of Elpue 1687
