 send greeting in our Lord God Everlasting Comfort Nathaniel
 Bradford late of the sd Countie deceased did by a certain
 writing obligatory under his hand and Seal bearing date
 the 10th day of November ann^o Dom 1680 bargain & sell
 to Jo^hn Wilkes Senior of the same place for and in consideration
 of seven thousand pounds of Tobacco and Cash by several
 filled part by the said John Wilkes in y^e aforesaid writing
 covenanted to be paid to the said hundred acres of land situate
 lying and being in the woods nere Matchapungo being
 the Plantation whereon James Dwell formerly dwelled
 bounded northward on y^e land of William Nock southward on
 the land of Bartholomew Mead and eastward by the marked
 tree of the land granted to Christopher Robin that said flower
 hundred acres of land being formerly granted to y^e said Nathaniel
 Bradford by Patent bearing date y^e ninth day of October
