The Deposition of Woodman Stockey aged 32 years on the 24th day
 That on Tuesday day at night your Petitioner was at m^r Wallops and there came m^r
 Wollum and Company to said Wallops of a foremade on Gimgobagies land
 and much importuning the said Wallops to remove the fence saying it was the
 business his thought and Wallops desiring that night consideration m^r Wollum
 very willing to goe home but m^r Wallops desired him to stay and much
 discourse there was concerning y^e land y^e m^r Wollum seemed to be angry
 about the said fencing the land and said it was not his building a house
 should deprive him of his Right and spoke sundry railing words out
 of his Company said it was pity that any of them should lose their
 lives about a piece of land whereupon m^r Wollum replied that if he
 did kill any of them the law would bear him out and that he designed
 out to morrow then I went home causing him there m^r Robbins being
 at my house I told him what m^r Wollum came about and what
 he said at m^r Wallops whereupon m^r Robbins replied y^e he came
 service he was welcome but if he came to hinder their design that
 they would let him and bring him of saying that he would be a good
 witness that was built a house there saying that it would trouble any
 of us to lose our Right for he had bin at great charges about it and that
 he had as much lost his life as what he had and further saith not

 immediate satisfaction for y^e about 5th shags & 3rd shag given to y^e about 5th
 Geo: Parker he only allowing y^e for y^e packing of 3 shags of tobacco alias
 execution

This day John Tustin Esq. his Majesties ^{lieut} Justice for y^e Countie of
 Northampton and Decomack on y^e Eastern Shore as well for his Majesties
 his Excellency Francis Lord Howard Govern^r of Virginia as for himself
 Exhibited an Informacon by m^r Charles Holden Attorney for and on
 the behalf of his Majesties constituted, giving the Court to understand
 that between the first day of May now past and the day of execution
 the said Informacon at Pungobagus in y^e Countie aforesaid had seized and
 arrested to y^e use of his Majesties his Excellency y^e Govern^r & himself as
 forfeited sundrie Goods and Merchandise particularly specified and set
 down in y^e said Informacon not being mentioned or contained in any of y^e Bonds
 Equit or Certificate as also had seized and arrested the said Ship or vessel called
 the Katherine, with all her Guns ammunition Cables apparell and furniture
 for that the said goods and every of y^e said kind of being goods & commodities
 of the growth production & manufacture of Europe were not bona fide
 without fraud laden & shipped in England Wales or Town of Berwick
 upon Tweed, neither had the Master of the said Ship delivered a full &
 perfect Inventory or Inward of her Lading together with the place or places
 in which the said goods were laden and taken into the aforesaid vessel
 contrary to y^e forms of severall Statutes in such case made and provided, and
 being that the said goods & ship with y^e furniture & ammunition thereof
 might remain forfeited and third part to his Majesties, and third part to
 his Excellency and y^e other, so y^e said John Tustin according to y^e forms of y^e
 Statutes in such case made and provided. The Court regarding the thereof to
 shew his authority whereby, to impower them to proceed upon that Informacon
 at that time and place M^r Charles Scarborough who claimed y^e property
 of y^e said Ship produced a Letter directed to him from his Excellency wherein
 it was intimated that the said Scarborough might if he thought necessary
 call a Court for tryall of y^e same, and the said John Tustin as his Master
 desired desiring that y^e Court might enter into examinacion of y^e said
 the Court thought fit to proceed thereon, and the said John Tustin producing
 a Equit Dated at Liverpool of part of y^e said Goods & Merchandise laden on
 board the said Ship alleged that y^e said Equit was unduly obtained &
 falsified and required that John Harrison Commander of the said Ship should make
 oath as an Act of Parliament in such case provided whether he came directly
