Greeting Whereas their Sacred majesties William and Mary by the
grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King and
Queen Defenders of the faith etc have by their Royal Letters
Patents under the great Seale of England bearing date at
Westminster the first day of March in the fourth yeare of
their Reign given and granted unto me full power and
authority to constitute and appoint Judges and in cases
requisite Comissioners of Oyer and Terminer Justices and
other necessary officers and ministers within this colony for
the administration of Justice and putting the Laws in execution
and whereas Information hath been made to me that an heinous
and detestable murder hath been committed in Accomack
County by one Indian Woman Slave belonging to Capt John
Nichols black named Jenny now in the Goal of this said
County, on the Body of a Bastard Child which the said Jenny
was delivered of & that therefore the said offender might be proce-
ded against according to Law I doo by virtue of their Majesties
said Letters Patents to me given and granted hereby constitute
Bayley Samuel Sanford Thomas Wolbourne Edmund Andros
Broadhurst & William Burton Gent and any four of you whosoever
any of you the said Charles Scarburgh Edmond Scarburgh and
Richard Bayley shall be one to enquire by Indictment or otherwise
of the truth of the said County and to enquire for the better discovery
of the said offence and the accessories thereof to enquire
thereof to enquire you or any four of you whosoever any of you the
said Charles Scarburgh Edmond Scarburgh and Richard Bayley
shall be one diligent inquiry to make in to the prison on such
day or dayes as you or any four of you as aforesaid shall appoint
within day of November next and to hear and determine the same
and to cause Justice and right to be done thereon according to Law
saving to their Majesties all annuities and other forfeitures
whatsoever shall appear to be due and to make return of your
proceedings therein to the office of Record at James City and
Command the Sheriff of the said County of Accomack that at
certain days and places which you or any of you the said
Charles Scarburgh Edmond Scarburgh and Richard Bayley
shall be one shall appoint him to come before them
