present time Sick and weak in body but of perfect memory
thank be to y^e almighty god and calling to Remembrance
the uncertaine Estate of this transitory Life and y^e all
flesh must yeald unto dea when it shall please god to call
me make constitute ordaine and declare this my last Will
and Testament in manner and forme following Revoking
and annulling by these presents all and Every Testaments
and Wills heretofore by me made or declared either in
word or writing and this is to be taken for my last Will
Testament and no other, I comitt my Soul to god gave
it be saving assuredly to be saved and to have full pardon
and Remission of all my sins and y^e my Soul when
+ Body att the generall day of Resurrection shall Rise again
with Joy and through y^e merits of Christ dea and pur
posess and Inheritt y^e Kingdom of heaven prepared for the
elect and Chosen, and my body to be decently Interred, and
for y^e settling of my Temporall Estate of such Lands houses
Chattles and Credits as it hath pleased god for above
years to bestow upon me I give order and dispose of y^e same
in manner and forme following that is to say I will y^e all
those debts w^{ch} I owne Right or Conscience to any manner of
person who ever may be well and truly contented and paid
ordained to be paid w^{ch} in convenient time after my dea
by my Execut^r hereafter named I have give and bequeath
unto my son William Whittington att y^e present value
I have y^e neck known by y^e name of Kingdwick
Estimation fifty acres more or less I give to y^e said Wm
Whittington his heires or assigns for ever

I have give and bequeath unto my son Edward Robin att y^e
parcell of Land lying on the Easternmost Side of poppet
Branch w^{ch} I bequeath unto him his heires or assigns for ever
In consideration of y^e said Land I have given Edward
Robin and his heires, he y^e said Ed Robin is to pay unto my
Execut^r four thousand pounds of Tobacco and Cask and
also to procure unto my afore said a parcell of Land lying
on the Westernmost Side of poppet Branch now belonging
his father Maso & John Robin and in said said Land

Edward Robins faithfull of parring & afore said tobacco
procuring & afore said parcell of Land, that the
aforesaid parcell of Land given him by this my
will and Testament my Returne to my Brother
Nathanial Littleton and Brother in Law Richard
Waters and there heires to dispose of it as they
shall see fit

Item I give and bequeath unto my Brother Nathanial
Littleton and Brother in Law Richard Waters my plantations
and rock of Land (Garsolia) with all the benefitts thereunto
belonging which I do ordaine may be equally becomen
them during their naturall Lives and also in naturall
Lives of their wives and after the decease of either parties
as Nathanial Littleton and his wife or Richard Waters
and his wife that theire part who shall first decease
may Returne immediately unto the other heire of my Brother
Nathanial Littleton Lawfully begotten of his Body and
+ for want of such heire unto the other heire of my Brother
Soutay Littleton Lawfully begotten of his Body and
for want of such heire unto my heire alcomon Law
and after the decease of the aforesaid parties as Nathanial
Littleton and his wife and Richard Waters and his
wife that then my whole rock of Land Garsolia
with my plantations and benefitts thereunto becomen
may immediately Returne unto the heires aforesaid
Item I give and will unto my Brother Soutay
a Silver Sall & Silver laced Sapper my Saddle horse
and Bell hatt

Item I give unto my Sister Custis a Silver Spoon

Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister Harmon
a Silver Spout and halfe doz powder peales

Item I give unto my Son Soutay Whittington two
Lives and three huffs of two yeares old sheep and
the 100 Chatts and Sheep to Run in my rock of Land
given by this my last will unto Nathanial Littleton
and Richard Waters the said Chatts & Sheep and
there after Increase to Run in aforesaid rock until
the aforesaid Soutay Whittington be twenty one yeares
of age

Item I give and bequeath unto my Brother
Nathanial Littleton my Muttat Boy Jack

Item I give unto my Brother in Law Richard
Waters my Negroe man Tom

Item I give and bequeath all the Rest of personall
Estate unto Nathanial Littleton and Richard Waters
during y^eil may be equally divided betwixt y^e

Scarburgh of the County of Accomack in Virg. aforesaid
by send greeting in our Lord God Everlasting Know
that by virtue of the power and authority by his ex
his Commission under his hand and the Seals of the Colony
bearing date 15th day of May ann Dom 1695 I have
unto the said Barth Scarburgh for the greater ease of Inhab
tants of this County to sign and Seals all such Probate
and administration as should be passed in Accomack
County by him and the same to be effectual to all
intent and purposes as if passed by his Excell^{ty} his Majesty
deceased did by his Last Will and Testament in writing
ordaine and appoint his Brother Nathaniel Sittaton of
Northampton County in Virg. afores. Gent and Richard
Bodwell of the County of Prince Georges in the Province of Maryland Esq^r
to be his Executors and to Nathaniel Sittaton alone
to be his Administrator of the County of Accomack June 13th 1696
Agreeing to the Court of said County for all my estate granted
and full power and full authority to
to dispose of all my personal and real estate
