In the name of god amen May 2nd anno Dom 1696
I Bowman Littleton of Accorhacck in Virginia being at this
present time sick and weak in body but of perfect memory
thank god almighty god and calling to remembrance
the uncertaine estate of this transitory life and full
flesh must yield unto death whom it shall please god to call
do make constiute ordaine and declare this my last will
and Testament in manner and forme following Revoking
and adnulding by these presents all and Every testament
and Wills before by me made or dictated either
word or writing and this is to be taken for my last will
testament and no other I committ my soule to god gave
it departing assuredly to be saved and to have full pardon
and remission of all my sins and my soule to him
+ body att the generall day of Resurrection shall rise again
with Joy and through the merits of Christ death undevit
posses and Inherit the Kingdom of heaven prepared for us
ewell and chosen and my body to be decently interred and
for settling of my temporale Estate of such Lands goods
chattels and Creditts as it shall please god far abou me
devisable to bestow vpon me I give and deposite of my sum
in manner and forme following that is to say I will tall
those debts w^{ch} I owe in Right of Conscience to any maner
person whoever may be vould and truly contented and desired
ordained to be paid vpon convenient time after my death
by my Execut^t & hereafter named Item I give and bequeath
unto my son Willm Whittington all y^t parcell of Land
I have in y^t neck knowne by y^t name of Long Neck &
Estimation fifty acres more or less I give to y^t said son
Whittington his houres or signes for ever

I give and bequeath unto my son Edward Robins all y^t
parcell of Land lying on the E^rmost Side of poppet
Branch w^{ch} I bequeath unto him his houres or signes for ever
In consideration of y^t said Land I have given Edward
Robins and his houres he^s said Ed Robins is to pay unto
Excut^t four thousand pounds of tobacco and laskards
also to procure unto my aforesaid a parcell of Land lying
on the westernmost Side of poppet Branch now abiding in
his father & also John Robins and in fitey shillings

Edward Robins fact of paring is before said tobacco
procuring my aforesaid parcell of Land that then
aforsaid parcell of Land given him by this my
will and testament my returne to my brother
Nathaniel Littleton and brother in Law Richard
Waters and thore hours to dispose of it as they
shall see fit

Item I give and bequeath unto my brother Nathaniel
Littleton and brother in Law Richard Waters my plantation
and neck of Land (Farsalia) with all benefits therin
belonging which I do ordain & may be equally between
them duringing thare natural lives and also in natural
lives of thore wives and at my decease of either party
as Nathaniel Littleton and his wife or Richard Waters
and his wife that thore part who shall first decease
may returne imediately unto & make hour of my brother
Nathaniel Littleton lawfully begotten of his body and

+ for want of such hour unto the whole house of my brother
Soutay Littleton lawfully begotten of his body and
for want of such hour vnto my house at common law
and at my decease of the aforesaid parties as Nathaniel
Littleton and his wife and Richard Waters and his

wife that then my whole neck of Land Farsalia
with plantations and benefits therin to them
may immediately returne unto them
Item I give and will vnto my brother Soutay
a Silver Sack & Silver buckled Chaiper my saddle horse
and Ben hatt

Item I give vnto my Sister Cestis a Silver spoon
Item I give and bequeath vnto my Sister Harmon
a Silver spoon and halfe dol souper plates
Item I give vnto my son Soutay Whittington two
lives and three tiffers of two yares old & one year old
the said Chaff and Sheep to Runn my neck of land
given by this my last will vnto Nathaniel Littleton
and Richard Waters the said Chaff & Sheep and
thare after increase to Runn in aforesaid Neck until
aforesaid Soutay Whittington becomyng one yare
of age

Item I give and bequeath vnto my Brother
Nathaniel Littleton my Mullat boy Jack

Item I give vnto my brother in Law Richard
Waters my negroe man Tom

Item I give and bequeath all rest of persons
estate vnto Nathaniel Littleton and Richard Waters
duringing yt may be equally devide betwixt

I do also by these presents constitute and ordaine
the aforesaid Nathaniel Littleton and Richard
Waters my just exectut of this my last will
testament as witness to the truth hereof have

in County of all to whom these presents shall come I Name
Scarburgh of the County of Accomack in Virg. aforesaid
Send Greeting in name of God Everlasting. Know by
that by virtue of his power and authority by his act
his Execution under his hand and Seal of this Colony
bearing date 26th day of May anno Dom 1695 impowern
me the said Scarburgh for the greater ease of his Inhabit
ants of this County to sign and Seal all such Probate
and Administrations as should be passed in Accomack
County timely and the same to be effectuall to all
mights and purposcs as if passed by his Execut^c bimscy
as was done by his late Will and Testament witness
or done and appoint his Brother Nathan Littleton of
Northampton County in Virg. afores. Gen^t and Richard
Evans of New Castle County in Province of Maryland joynt
Executors of his late Will and Testam^t of the said Scarburgh to be
done by them in the name of Accomack June 26th 1696
and by them to be sealed with their hands and countersigned
and by them to be delivered unto the said Nathan Littleton
and Rich. Evans to discharge all and sing^e his goods Right
legitimate and dearest according to his last Will and Testament
of doct^r 16th 1695 deposed according to his last Will and Testament
hereunto annexed and to be reduced according thereto
in Washbourn Color

In the name of God amen I Daniel Boyles being weak
of body but of disposing mind & memory prayed to do
for the same doo make this my last Will & Testament
manner & form following That is first & principally
resigne my Sout^r m^r to the hands of God my Creator
hoping through the merits of Jesus Christ to receive
my pardon & forgiveness of my sins at the resurrection
of me I give & Bequeath unto my helpefull friend Peter
Morgan my gun with all my working tools & other
utensils except hereafter accepted with me to have and

use I give & Bequeath unto my trusty friend Mr. Bowm^r
my most usefull instrument for distillation hinc
with the worm or rather Serpentine wth all other
necessaries wth measure with all sorts of rakes, scalders
