some make by, and under the my last will & Testament in memory
of all might God my make Hoping through the Death &
possession of my Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ to receive the pardon
and forgiveness of all my Sins and as for my body to be
buried at the Discretion of my Executor hereafter named

- first I give and bequeath my Plantation being one hundred and fifty
acres to my mother and my Sister for their Lifetimes and
after their Deceases to Pinell Richardson and his heirs for ever
I give my mother four Cows two Calves & two yearlings
I give my mother one bed and what house hold stuff I have
I pay my all my last debts
I give my sister one Curren Cow & one horse of depth
for Richardson plantation
I give John Burlington two Sows and pigs
I give Sarah Richardson one Ape
I give William Richardson one Ape
I give Charles Richardson one Ape
I give one gun to John Richardson Jr.
I give my Bible & Bible to Thomas Richardson
I give my horse to Geo. Richardson
I give all my Cows & what other Cattle I have to my
mother and also give her Daughters head of Hogs and three
hides of Leather & is now at tanning
and with good will I give I give to my mother
and lastly I make my mother sole executress of this my
last will & Testament Hoping all other wills & Testaments
whatsoever as witness my hand and stroke the Day and year first
above written

I do hereby certify that I Simon Michael of the County of Accomack
 do hereby assign and Confine to my brother John Michael and to his heirs for ever all my right properties and Interest that I have might or could be entitled to of my deceased brother Doakins Michael's entire personal or real estate and also I do hereby alien Confine and assign and set over to my said brother John Michael all my right properties and interest of or to two hundred acres of Land lying being in the fourth fourth hundred acres belonging to my deceased father and the said two hundred acres falling to me by the death of two of my Sisters Rights belonging or appertaining to the said Doakins Michael and the said two hundred acres which all privileges and Conventions now in Confine assign deliver and set over to my said brother John Michael and to his heirs or assigns for ever in as full and ample manner as if same belong to me for that neither I nor any person come claiming or demand any right properties or Interest to the said two hundred Acres and appertinances but of and from all right title or Interest there to shall and will be for ever excluded and withheld by these presents

The within Deed was acknowledged in open Court of Accomack County by Simon Michael and Susanna his wife as their voluntary act and Deed, to John Michael November 4th 1708

Recorded December 4th 1708 To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Accomack
 Know all men by these presents that I John Michael late of the County of Accomack Esq. of Northampton in Virginia being possessed of a certain plantation in Accomack containing two hundred acres of Land situate being by the last will and testament of my father and for years gone and English Camp near the said moving but more especially whereas by the death of my father Doakins Michael there was an Estate fell to me and my brother Simon Michael and to the said Simon being willing to deliver up all his right properties and interest in and to the said Estate to me the said John Michael and in consideration of his so doing I the said John Michael do hereby alien assign Confine deliver and set over to the said Simon Michael and to his heirs or assigns for ever all my right title and Interest to the said plantation and two hundred acres with all houseing plant and all other privileges or Conventions belonging or appertaining to the said Land and plantation to him the said Simon and to his heirs and assigns for ever in full and ample manner to all intents and purposes as if same was given to me for that neither I the said John Michael nor any other person by them or under me shall or will at any time hereafter come claiming or demand any right properties or Interest to the said Land and plantation but of and from all right interest or properties there to shall and will be for ever excluded and withheld by these presents
