Send Greeting in open God Everlasting knowly
that by vertue of his power and authority by his act
his Execution under his hand and Seal of this Colony
bearing date 26th day of may anno Dom 1695 impowern
me the said Scarburgh for the greater ease of his Inhab
itors of this County to sign and Seal all such Probate
and Administrations as should be passed in Accomack
County timely and the same to be effectuall to all
mights and purposcs as if passed by his Execut^c bimscy
as wased by his late Will and Testament in which
ordine and appoint his Brother Nathan Littleton of
Northampton County in Virg. afores. Gen^t and Richard
Evans of New Castle County in Province of Maryland goyn^r
the first day of October in the year of our Lord 1696 to be ma
nagers of his estate in the County of Accomack June 26th 1696 ma
naged by them now and for ever to have and to receive all power and
privileges as if he were alioe and to have all authority to
execute and discharge all and singlary goods Right
privileges and franchises belonging to his Estate and to manag^r of
it to the best of his power and to be responsible for the same
as if he were alioe

In the name of God amen I Daniel Boyles being weak
of body but of disposing mind & memory prayed to God
for the same doo make this my last Will & Testament
manner & form following That is first & principally
resigne my Sout in to the hands of God my Creator
hoping through the merits of Jesus Christ to recieve
my pardon & forgiueness of my sinnes at the resurrection
of me I give & Bequeath unto my helpefull friend Peter
Morgan my gun with all my working tools & other
utensils except hereafter accepted with me to have and

to give & Bequeath unto my trusty friend Mr. Bowm^c
my most usefull instrument for distillation hinc
with the worm or rather Serpentine wth all other
necessaries & measeur with all sorts of rakes, scythes,

with what brandy shall be in his custody at my death
without poll meddles I shall leave whome I dooming to my
sole Execut^e of this my last Will & Testament to
divide and pay all my debts & the remainder to be
with him & his heires for Ever together wth all my
bookes & herentos I set my hand & seal this 28 day
January 9th

the Colony bearing date 16th day of May anno Dom
1695 impowering me to saye at Scawburgh
greater part of Elecomack County for
that all such Dayes and a daies thereafter as should
pass in Elecomack County to all and y^e same to be effectuall
to all intent & purpose as if passed by his Excellency
Sir C^r Andros Daniel Boyles Cap^t of this County
deceased did by his said Com^t & Testam^t in writing now
be appoint William Barnes of y^e afores. County of Elecomack
of y^e County of Elecomack June 16th 1696/97pm
that he receive a Prove of y^e Testam^t & make him
an informer & sue proce & lawfull audience & he
shall be signified unto him to claim payement to his use of all
sugars & goods & victuals & cedars & trees & land & property
in Elecomack County & elsewhere Elecomack & Elecomack
in a certaine sume of money to be paid to him
my self & other as of y^e day of y^e deceased given me

On the name of God Amen Nathaniel Tunell
Elecomack County Com^t & Seal of mind & of good repute
memory cord I that al men are mortal & y^e time of death
uncertaine do therefore for y^e settling my Estate after my
death do make this my last will & Testament

+ First I make null and void all other of my former wills
and Testaments whatsoever and doo byg^t death my soul
to God y^e gave it and my body to bee buried in Christian
maner baring at the said day to be raised to a glorious
and happy home and after my just debts and funeral
charges paid I will and boogath all y^e rest of my well
Estate and goods as followeth

First I give and boogath to my son Washbourn Tunell
now dwelling there with all the other our soule
thaded unto Elecomack and to one fifth part of my total
hundred acres of land more or less to Elecomack him selfe
