temporall concerns wth a full & ample Authority as if I was personally
present particularly to demand receive all my just debts and upon
receipt to give full & ample discharge and upon refusal of paym^t to sue
impnd and recover by due course of Law and upon Judgment & Execution
obtained to imprison and upon paym^t to release from imprisonment to
legally to acquit & discharge to pay all my just debts wth out charge or Lawfully
if made without & plainly to appear & further impower and appoint
them to sue for recover and manage the Estate of M^r James Mathews
and Children to wth I give my also Wife and appointed & as also to acknowledge
renovoy & confirm a deed of Sale for Land sold to John Hutton & his heirs
forever And I do by these words ratify & confirm aforesaid and whatsoever
my & Attys that do or shall to be done in a full & ample manner
about the premises for his end use & behoofe before mentioned as if
I myself were personally present to wth I put my hand & seal this
thirteenth day of May Anno 3rd 1704
