and whereas Henry Read Senio^r late of this County deceased
did by his Last Will & Testament in writing Ordain and
appoint Mary Polist of the said Henry Read's sole executrix
of his said last Will; w^{ch} said Mary did as a Justice in
Accomack County November 19th 1695 make a Probate shul-
to y^e said Probate of y^e said Will my a^o granted
unto her for w^{ch} cause full power and Lawfull authority
is hereby given & granted unto her to dispose of all and
singular the goods Right & Credits of the said deceased
according to the true intent and meaning of his said last

do hereby acknowledge and of every part and parcel thereof

Parker his heirs executrix and assigns the said Samuell
Pittman bargained sold assigned Envoiced confirmed and
delivered like as by these presents I do give to said Philip
Parker his heirs executrix and assigns confirmed and delivered
for ever two hundred acres of Land situate lying and
being in the County of Accomack in Virginia aforesaid adjoin-
ing to the house and Plantacon of the said Samuell
Pittman and formerly the Land of Henry Scarborough
two hundred acres of Land bounded as followeth Beginning
at Edmunds his Branch and so running along the line of
Pitts his Land to a corner tree from thence West nine poles
Northely one hundred thirty two poles to a marked tree
the line of James Taylors Land thence running East
North one fourth Northely to a corner tree then running
West by West one fourth Westely four hundred and thirty
poles to a corner tree and so running up the forks of the said
Land made by John Walker for Henry Scarborough
