their Maj^{ties} Justices of Peace of the said County with good and
sufficient Security in y^e penal sum of one hundred pounds
pounds of Tobacco to our Sovereign Lord and Lady the King
Queen their Heires and Successors to render unto the Auditors
or such others as shall be appointed to receive the same a
perfect and full account of all their Maj^{ties} Revenues at
the said County during the time of your Sheriffdom and
that you shall due payment make of all such Publicque dues or
be Levied in the aforesaid County of Accomack unto his several
persons that shall be appointed to receive the same and to
make of all things belonging to y^e office of Sheriff of the aforesaid
and I do hereby Command all their Maj^{ties} officers both Civil and
military and all other their Maj^{ties} Subjects that are inhabiting the
said County and others actually here to be aiding and assisting to
the said George Parker as high Sheriff in all things relating to the
office of Sheriff of the aforesaid County Given under my hand and
the Seals of the Colony this 26th day of April in the fifth year
of their Maj^{ties} Reign Annoy Dom 1694
