This ninth of August in y^e year of our Lord God 1709
 I John Dowers of Accomack being in perfect
 health and sound in mind and memory thanks be
 to God for it and I do here make & ordaine this
 my last will and Testament in manner and forme
 as followeth that is to say first and chiefly I give
 and bequeath my soule into y^e hands of almighty
 God who gave it me and my body I comitt to y^e
 earth to be decently buried in Christian Buriall at y^e
 discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at
 y^e generall resurrection I shall receive y^e same
 againe by the mighty power of God and as touching
 my worldly estate where with it hath pleased God
 to bless me with I give devise bequeath and dispose of y^e same
 in manner and forme as followeth

I give and bequeath unto my son Bowles the title of my land at Nandua it being that part of my plantation whereon I now live and also to have his Equall breadth of y^e maine Creek as also into y^e woods for his Equall breaddth to him his heires ~~and~~ assigns but in case my son John Bowles should dye leaving no heire or y^e land not being sold, then this said land is to fall to my son Danvers Bowles to him his heires or assigns

I give and bequeath unto my son Daniel Rowley if
other halfe of my Land at Nantua that part next
to Michael Richard, he also to have his Equall bred
on y^e main freed and also into y^e woods for his
equall bredth to him his heires or assignes
but in case my son Daniel ^{Rowley} should die leaving
no heires or his Land not being sold then this
Land is to fall to my son John Rowley to him his
heires or assignes and also I give to my son Dan
Rowley one feather bed and lugg

I give and bequeath unto my son Jonathan Bowles the one half of my
Land at Bungo leaguin it being that part next the mill dam to him and his
heirs or assigns and he to have his Equall breadth on y^e maine branch and
also into y^e woods for his Equall breadth so to be Equally divided but in
case my son Jonathan Bowles should die leaving no heirs or the Land not
sold then this Land fall to my son Major Bowles him his heirs or assigns

I give and bequeath unto my son Major Bowles the other half of my Land
at Bungo leaguin it being that part adjoining upon Richard Jones to him his
heirs or assigns he also is to have his Equall breadth on y^e maine branch
or also into y^e woods he is to goe for his Equall breadth and so to be
Equally divided but in case my son Major Bowles should die leaving
no heirs or his Land not being sold then this Land is to fall to my
son Jonathan Bowles him his heirs or assigns I also give to my son
Major Bowles a feather bed and fagg & great Chest

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza Beth West one feather bed
and fagg

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ellinor Bowles the best feather
bed called the great bed with the best great fagg boulders Count
-erpane and all things thereto belonging and also my Hamock and
Pole and y^e Little Iron Vettle and y^e great new powder bason and y^e
Linnen wheele and woollin wheele and also a horse either young or
old which I put to her choice which please her best I also give my
Daughter Ellinor Bowles whole Com and of my now dwelling house at
Nandua with milkehouse and kitchen with free privilege of y^e Land to
plant to make some or also pasturing for her sheep and cattle with free
priviledg and privilege to raise hogs or any thing else what so ever all
during her maid hood

I also give and bequeath unto my four Children Daniel Bowles Jonathan
Bowles Major Bowles & Ellinor Bowles all my sheep to be Equally
divided amongst them four as also I give unto Jonathan & Major three
priviledg for pasture at Nandua as also they are to help to repair y^e
fences worst in y^e yeare

I give and bequeath unto my six Children all the remaining part of my
estate to be Equally divided amongst them all and also I doe hereby
thefe my beloved Children John Bowles Daniel Bowles Jonathan Bowles
and Major Bowles to be my Executors and Equall with them my two Daughters
Elizabeth & Ellinor to be my Executors of this my last will and Testament
and I doe hereby utterly disallow revoke and annul all and every other former
Testaments wills legacies bequests and excopts by me in any writt before this
time named willed and bequeathed hathing and confirming this and no other
to be my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seale the Day of y^e yeare above written signed sealed
delivered and pronounced and Declared by me as my last will and Testament
