In the Name of God Amen I John Hutton being sick of body but of perfect and whole
 Remembrance glory and praise be to Almighty God my body I bequeath unto the grave
 to be buried and there to remaine untill the generall resurrection what Estate I am
 now possessed with it is my last will and Testament that it be disposed of as followeth
 my land I give to my son William Hutton and his heirs for ever only one third to
 my wife Elizabeth Hutton during her life time moreover I give more forth I give
 to my son William Hutton that to be granted for him at proving this my last will &
 Testament this which is mentioned is all I give to my son William Hutton my personal
 Estate to my wife Elizabeth Hutton I leave Eleven head of Sheep and six head of
 cattle and three sheeps for ever to my wife Elizabeth I also leave my young horse
 and old mare as for the remaining part of my Estate and I leave not before mention
 ed I leave to my wife providing she continue a widow but if in case she marry
 she or her husband shall be obliged to give in good sufficient bail for y^e delivery
 -ance of this afores^d remaining part of Treasures to be Equally divided among
 -st the rest of my Children I particular give to my daughter Eve Hutton one
 feather bed all the remaining part of my personal Estate I give to my wife Elizabeth
 Hutton I also leave my beloved wife Elizabeth Hutton and my Brother John
 Hittgarrell Executors jointly and severally of this my last will and Testament
 as witness my hand and seal this first day of April Ano 1709

This Indenture made the twenty third day of May in y^e year of our Lords one
 thousand seven hundred and nine and in the eighth year of our sovereign
 Ann of great Brittain France and Ireland Queen Defender of the faith &c
 Betweene Nicolas Milledopp of y^e County of Accomack in y^e Colony of Virginia
 Farmer of the one part and John Murraine of the 3^d place planter of y^e
 other part witnesseth that y^e Nicolas for a valuable consideration he
 have received the receipt thereof I doe acknowledge to be fully paid and so Hitherto
 before y^e signing and delivery hereof and for every other good cause and for
 him y^e Nicolas thereunto moving hath given ample bargain above
