In the name of God amen I John Wallop alias Wadlow of  
 Accomack County in Virginia being well in health & of sound  
 and perfect mind & memory touching this uncertainty of death  
 do make this my last will & testament in forme & manner following  
 I give & bequeath my Soule to God that gave me it & my body to  
 God & wher I shal be buried hoping at y<sup>e</sup> last day to be raised againe from  
 the dead and to enjoy the Kingdom of Heaven

Secondly - after all my funerall charges & just debts are fully satisfied &  
 paid I will bequeath all my worldly goods Land & Estate as  
 followeth

First I give & bequeath unto my Son Skinner Wallop als Wadlow my  
 parcer room & Closet and the Loft over them and y<sup>e</sup> Loft over the  
 Collee and y<sup>e</sup> Smiths Shop & weavers Shop and Cann<sup>o</sup> Shop & my  
 sixty foot Tobacco house and some ground for three hands & my  
 part of my Plantation that he shal y<sup>e</sup> year choose & buy not y<sup>e</sup> best  
 ground for Tobacco & Tobacco ground in any place that he shal y<sup>e</sup> year  
 like and choos on my plantation enough for two hands to tend and a  
 privilege for his cattle horses Sheep & Pigs to graze pasture & be raised  
 in my Pasture about the house & to make both the Law & order of the  
 same

one & taking his number of trees together my north west side of 400 or  
to have and to hold all things and priviledges & moeres whatsoever ment  
ab about in this first lease for and during the time of seven yeares after my  
death or till he shall have built a dwelling house and a tobacco house and  
found in a time foild on his land which shall in y<sup>e</sup> second Cause following  
give him which shall first hapen

secondly -

I give and bequeath unto my son Skinner Wallop all Wadlow mintson  
hundred eight & five acres of Land or thereabouts be it more or less situated  
one the East & Southeast Side of Grigoteag Creek one y<sup>e</sup> name Land of  
Accomack County in Virginia bounding Southwest on the North east side  
of four hundred acres of Land w<sup>ch</sup> shall in y<sup>e</sup> third clause next following  
give unto my daughter Sarah Wallop all Wadlow bounded on y<sup>e</sup> North  
Grigoteag Channel running between of y<sup>e</sup> Sea Side to a little that is  
partly by y<sup>e</sup> Little Gut and Fourmose Schoon Bay or Shallow Joans and  
marshes unto the mouth of y<sup>e</sup> Danfats Branch also I give unto my son  
at Crooked Creek in Accomack County and y<sup>e</sup> Land thereunto belonging  
also I give unto him my Post & Raitt Pen one y<sup>e</sup> Land Ranch at y<sup>e</sup> mouth  
of the Creek in my old pasture & y<sup>e</sup> Land within y<sup>e</sup> Pen for a Landing  
place to land or boat off horses cattle sheep hogs & other creatures you  
or passengers w<sup>ch</sup> priviledge of Eggs & regrett at all every time or time  
thereunto and from to have & to hold y<sup>e</sup> Pen nineteen hundred eight  
four acres of Land more or less & the said house at m<sup>r</sup> Andersons point  
at Crooked Creek w<sup>ch</sup> the Land belonging to y<sup>e</sup> Pen for a  
Landing place as aforesaid w<sup>ch</sup> the priviledges as aforesaid unto him  
said Skinner Wallop all Wadlow for and during his natural life &  
remainder to the heirs of his body lawfully begotten the remainder

To have & to hold the said four hundred acres of Land to y<sup>e</sup> said  
Sarah Wallop all Wadlow for & during her natural life &  
Remainder to y<sup>e</sup> heirs of her body the Remainder to my son

I bequeath my soule into y<sup>e</sup> hand of God my Creator & for ever  
blessed Reddemptor in whom alone I have my hope & confidence and  
from whom I have all comforts corporall spiritual & eternall  
& my body to the earth and to be buried neare y<sup>e</sup> place where  
my former wives were interred and that there be a decent  
and christian buriall had as I hope by the merits of my  
Saviour to obtaine a happy resurrection at y<sup>e</sup> last day and  
to receive such inheritance among his people w<sup>ch</sup> he hath  
provided for all that believe in him

And as for that worldly portion God hath bin pleased to bestow  
upon far beyond my deserts I doe dispose & bequeath as  
followeth Inprimis I give and bequeath unto my son Owen  
Collony the Plantacon I now live on containing thre hundred  
acres of Land w<sup>th</sup> all houses & other appurtenances belonging  
to it, to him & his heirs for ever
