 my last will and Testament in manner and forme following In presence of my wife and bequeath
 my stock unto the hands of Almighty God which gave it me and my Body unto the
 Earth from whence it came to have a Burial and Christian Buryall as becometh a Christian
 to have and for my words, Estate that God of his meritys hath been pleased to bestow upon
 me and my family as followeth Viz -
 I give and bequeath unto my Loving wife Elizabeth Watson on the plantation where I
 now live with one hundred thirty five acres of land belonging to it During the life
 of her widows days but no longer and after her marriage or Death if not marrying to
 my Son John Watson and his heirs for ever - -

and by my will unto my son David Watson the plantation whereon my son
Watson now dwells with one hundred thirty five acres of land belonging to it to him
and his heirs for ever -

my wife and three of my four sons James, John and Roger the
head and plantation whereon he now dwells, until his mother Maria or
when he goes off to leave the plantation both for fencing and conveying
and Order and for a while. - - - - - I have - - - - - I have - - - - -

and I bequeath unto my two sons to wit Robert and John that tract of
land which I bought of Daniell and Dorman fillonant Esq^r my
part Ide of Occochanock Creek to be Equally Divided between them that is
to say from the Creek unto y^e head of the Land but my will and Desire is
that my Son Robert shall have his Share in the Division that is when
it is Divided to them and there heirs for Ever

give and 33 pence
unto my son David Wallson my son
unto my son John one large

 I leave it unto my Loving wife Elizabeth with an ever lasting
