 three Dns to y^e by their fashy wife. I also give to my son
 William two Long Table-Clothes y^e was made for y^e Long Table
 when I was bound up of bottles & a Dish was his fashy & also
 his choice of y^e two hackles my hand-mill all y^e hables my boy
 the glass lights the 2^d Iron in y^e house. And also all my
 Corn & oth^r Grain. I give my son William's son Thomas
 William my horse & a Chick in fowls
 I give to my son Thomas Burlon a New Red Tucking Iron
 I give also six ewes and a ram And my part of y^e horse
 Also five pounds sterling in Money And a small Kettle
 I give to my son Thomas his wife my side-saddle & bridle
 Buckle & a hand my mantle & a Lappet-garment
 I give to my son Thomas his two Children Thomas & Anne
 and each of y^e moid cow & calves And to his daughter Anne
 a two year old heifer
 I give unto my son Benjamin a hackle a go-hall a pair
 of hounds & tobacco for what he ad my horse for his & also a cow
 Cattle at the Plantation excepting one Cow & calves which I give to my
 son William And one Cow & calves which I give to his daughter Anne
 And one two year old heifer to his son John And also excepting
 two of y^e best sheeps which I give to my son Joseph - And also a two
 year old heifer which I give to Joseph Burlon's son And also a two
 year old heifer which I give to my son Matton's daughter
