bed and all appurtenances there unto belonging; also I
give unto my So^d Son W^m my livery Cupboard now stand-
ing in his house and also my Great Chest together with
four Pewter platters and a quart pott two Iron potts
and two Whelers & one ewe & Lamb to be belonging now
in the Custody of my son John Meers

To the rest of my children Vizt: John Richard Robt.
Elizabeth Mary and Dorothy I give to each of them
twelve once and more I give to my son John my Sennet
Stillette and appurtenances and a sett of wedges and rings
and one frying pan And I hereby constitute and appoint my
son William Meers to be sole Execut^e of this my Last
Will and Testament revoking and hereby disannulling all
other Wills and Testaments by me formerly made In witness
hereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seal this 28th day
of July Anno Domini 1703
