Colony bearing date the 11th day of May ann^o Dom 1695 impow-
ering the said Charles Scarborough for the greater ease of the
Inhabitants of this County to Sign and Seal all such Probate
and Administrations as should be passed in Accomack
County Court and the same to be effectual to all intents
and purposes as if passed by his Excellency himself in which Charles
Richard Sturgis late of this County deceased do by his last
will & Testament in writing becom^e & appoint his say
Sarah Polist of the said Richard Sturgis his whole
Ex^{ec}utor of his said last will, which said Sarah Polist
at a Court holden in Accomack County September the 1st
1696 make humble Suit by Court Writ to a Probate of the said
will might be granted unto her for which cause full
power and Lawfull authority is hereby given & granted
unto her the said Sarah Polist of full & singular
the goods rights and Credits of the said deceased according
the true intent and meaning of the said last will and
Testament expressed and to render an account thereof
when thereunto Lawfully required Given under my
