Item I give unto my grandson Dorian Colony in Glano Neck of Lune
up to his house faire towards Kellams Land & bounching therewarde
by 3 three hundred acres formerly given his father Dorian Colony
likewise one Cow called Hooly mouth & one Mare called Dore

Item Item I give & Bequeath unto my sonn Law William in
one halfe of his profitts of an Orchard upon the land given
before unto my grand son Dorian Colony for a space of
seven years notwithstanding his former ground provided
that he do William Sill Keape and maintaine his orchard
fence in sufficient reparaition likewise I give him in
by a great pasture for his owne creatures in my garden
together wth my sonn own Colony for a space of seven years
provided that he do help my sonn own Colony to keep up
sufficient fence therew^r the same to be ordered in
my manning about his orchard fence by the contribution due by
to the maintaining of his same

clad with purple baies & his wife one Cow called prettie

Item I gave unto Arnold Harrison my Son in Law a purple Gown
Item To my Son in Law William Sill a red peny Stone Waste coale

As for the rest of my Estates my Pop, my debts & all other in
without dower within of ffeild land or quarells never
giv^d an^d Bequeath unto my Sonn own Colony and do fforbid
and appoynt him my sole Executour of this my last Will &
Cestamant and to be that all my debts be paid before there
my Legacys justly & duely performed moreover frequently
desirous my friend Mr Thomas Beach to be a trustee and
overseer of what concerne^s my grandson Dorian Colony
what is given him before by this my past Will & Execution

of my Land, giving my Grandson Charles to carry it on
to him & his heirs for ever moreover my Will is of my
secret & delivered unto my Daughter Elizabeth & her family

is Lawfull wife of Edmund Scarborough of County of Accomack
in Virginia Gent. Do make, ordame constatace and appoinct
John Washbourne of same place Carrying true and
Lawfull attorney for me and my name & stead to acknowledge
in Accomack County Court these several and Respective (markes)
& Deeds of Land Given Grants aliened and sold by my said
Edmund Scarborough my now husband to my sundry & respective
persons herein hereafter mentioned & specified & specifically w^tth
Given to my Daughter Anna the now wife of Capt Richard Tucke
one hundred and eighty acres of Land to Wm Staker Sold Two
hundred and eight acres of Land to Thomas Nicholson one thousand
acres of Land to Henry Burton Sixty three acres of Land, by James
Loary hundred five acres of Land to John Simcock one hundred
sixty five acres of Land and to Reynold Badger one hundred and
fifty acres of Land in all nine hundred and one acres of Land
out of that divided out of Land belonging to my aforesaid husband
commonly called and known by the name of White Marsh Land
