-lliam Major to her her heirs and assigns for ever

all y^e rest of my Estate whatsoever or wheresoever in any part
of y^e world after my just debts are p^d I give and bequeath unto
my loving brother William Major to him his heirs and assigns
for ever

-t my 3^d Brother William Major to be my Executor in writing
whereof & that this is my last will & Testament I have her
