 Thrice Thousand pounds of good tobacco & Cash the Receipt whereof I
 do hereby acknowledge and of every part and parcel thereof do for
 ever quit claim unto and discharge the said Richard Rogers his heirs
 Executors and Administrators having given granted alienated Bargained
 sold assigned Enfeoffed confirmed and delivered like as by these
 presents I do give grant a free Bargain and Sale aforesaid Conform
 to y^e Deed unto y^e said Richard Rogers his Heirs and Assignees for ever
 a parcel of Land situate lying & being in y^e County of Accomack
 aforesaid at y^e head of great Nuswatoch other wise called Induna
 Creek Containing one hundred Acres Beginning at y^e maine Creek
 and bounded at the head between two Branches from y^e Creek and so
 running between them a foresaid two Branches Easterly up to y^e
 west for ought to make up & Comptat y^e aforesaid Quantity of
 one hundred acres of Land formerly in the Possession & Occupation of
 William (late) since deceased R^d said one hundred Acres of Land being
 the one Moysie or halfe part of a Division of Land of four hundred
 Acres formerly given & granted unto y^e said John Ronies, to have
 and to hold the said One hundred Acres of Land together w^t all
