In p^{re}miss I give to Peter Turlington sen^r one cow called Colly and all my Work Tools and fags & 1s of mark
2 I give his son Peter Turlington one cow a calf called young Colly
3 I give to Mary Turlington one feather bed and covering one cow named Star
4 I give to Thomas Turlington one yoke and one horn pott holding about four gallons
5 I give to John Turlington one pott about three gallons and pott hook one yoke and lame
6 I give one yoke lame to mamefid Turlington
7 my Will is that Mary Turlington if she marrieth a man that hath no pott my will is that either of her brothers Thomas or John Turlington shall lend her a pott a reasonable time till she can one
