Item I give and bequeath to my son Nathaniel Bell one feather bed & boulder a rug a pair of Blankets and a pair of sheets and I desire my Brother in law Robert Bell to furnish with a gun out of my Estate and that wth I have herein given him may be delivered unto him at such time as his father in his discretion shall think meet and convenient

Item I give unto my sister Dorothy Surfen One Shilling

Item I give unto my sister Anne Laylor One Shilling

Item I give ten shillings to be paid unto the hands of 4 overseers for y^e meeting house to be by them disposed off to y^e friends as to them I shall see meet and fitting

Item All y^e residue and remainder of my Estate Real an personall whatsoever = or my debts paid an funerall expences discharged, I give and bequeath said Brother in law Robert Bell sole executor of this my last will and testament revoking and hereby annulling all other wills and Testaments what soever by me formerly made and do publish and declare this to be my last will & testament And in Witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand and seale y^e day and year first above written
