 small outward estate which god in his great mercy hath bestowed
 upon me and as followeth

First I Bequeath my soul to god hoping hoping to obtaine remission of my
 sins through the merits of my lord and saviour Jesus Christ second
 I desire that my body may be decently buried according to the cus-
 tom of my friends in Christ

Third and lastly I Bequeath unto my Daughter Margaret Darter my now
 plantation with all the pertinances thereto belonging to
 her and her heirs and assigns for ever being one hundred and fifty
 acres lying and being as my conveyance doeth for nearly the land
 of Lawrence Robinson: also I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter
 Margaret Darter twenty acres of salt marsh which I bought of
 William Harmon lying and bounding as my conveyance men-
 tioneth to her and her heirs for ever

Also I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Margaret Darter all my
 goods and chattels to her and her heirs and assigns for ever with
 the whole interest thereof of both within and without

I do bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Hudson one halfe of my
 personall estate with the increase thereof during her naturall
 life: and at her death to returne to my Daughter Margaret
 Darter with the whole interest and what interest thereof: and
 she said Mary Hudson my now wife shall not remove anything
 of good, or chattel of any my now plantation nor shall not sell
 nor dispose of any good, or chattel from my fore Daughter first
 if she want for sickles or clothing my Executors shall
 procure it for her: provided she doth not dispose of it to any one

I also bequeath unto my wife Mary Hudson one fire room in my
 now dwelling house and helpe my pleasure ground for her cur-
 use but for no other to dwell with her during her naturall life
 I do here Appoynt William Darter my son in law to be
 my Executor of my last will and testaments wholly and fully
 to act and doe according to his Direction without deniall
 of any person whatsoever as witnes my hand and Seal
