I William Wait of Accomack in y<sup>e</sup> Colony Virg<sup>ia</sup> being at this present time  
sick and weak in body but of perfect memory thanks be to God thought  
and falling to remembrance the uncertain estate of this Transitory life and  
all flesh must speed unto death when it pleaseth God to call doe make  
ordaine and declare this my last will and Testament in Manner and forme  
following Revoking and Annulling by these y<sup>e</sup> words all and every Testaments  
and will heretofore by me made or delivered either in word or writing  
is to be taken for my last will and Testament and no other first or  
revised or sorry for my sins most humbly desiring forgiveness for  
I give and commit my soule unto God my Saviour and redeemer in whom I  
aspire to be saved and to have full pardon and remission of all sins  
my soule w<sup>th</sup> my body at y<sup>e</sup> generall day of resurrection shall rise againe  
joy and through y<sup>e</sup> merit of Christ death and passion profit and further  
of heaven prepared for his elect Chosen and my body to y<sup>e</sup> grave to be  
decent buriall and now for y<sup>e</sup> settling of my temporall estate of y<sup>e</sup> goods  
I do as it hath pleased God forgive my debts to bestow upon  
I do give order and dispose of y<sup>e</sup> same in Manner and forme following  
I will that all those debts and duties which I owe in right or conscience to any  
manner of person whatsoever may be well and truly contented & paid or  
to be paid within convenient time after my decease by my Executors  
I then I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Wait my plantation  
& tract of land whereon I dwell to him his heirs and assigns forever  
I then I give and bequeath unto my son Nathaniel Wait a certain tract of land  
lying in Maryland called Tanners Hall to him his heirs and assigns forever  
I then I give and bequeath unto my son William Wait three thousand pounds  
of tobacco to be paid unto my aforesaid son William Wait out of my personal  
-well estate in due of his part of Land  
I then I give and bequeath unto my loving wife during her whole life the  
best of my personal estate but if she should marry my wife  
it should at y<sup>e</sup> day of marriage be divided between my three  
three sons  
I do hereby nominate and appoint my loving wife to be the  
Last will and Testament

This Indenture made the twenty eighth day of July in y<sup>e</sup>  
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eight  
 and in y<sup>e</sup> year of the reign of our sovereign Lady  
 Anne by the grace of God of Great Brittain France  
 and Ireland Queen etc between Thomas Millman of  
 Accomack County in the Colony of Virginia Tanner of y<sup>e</sup>  
 one part and William Belk of the said County planter  
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas  
 Millman for a valuable consideration in hand received  
 of the s<sup>d</sup> William Belk before the sealing and delivery  
 hereof the receipt thereof I acknowledge to be fully satisfi-  
 ed and paid and for other good causes and considerations  
 him therunto moving have given granted bargained  
 Aliened sold in feoff and confirmed and by this present  
 doth freely clearly and absolutely give grant bargain  
 sell release and confirm unto y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> William Belk  
 his heirs and assigns for ever two hundred acres of Land  
 being part of four hundred acres of Land which  
 purchased of Christopher Glass and Gerthemia his wife  
 of Sumners County in y<sup>e</sup> province of Maryland as by a  
 deed bearing date August 17<sup>th</sup> 1700 may appear in y<sup>e</sup> year one  
 thousand seven hundred and six situated in Accomack and  
 bounded as mentioned in the afores<sup>d</sup> deed and now sold and  
 made over unto y<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> William two hundred acres of y<sup>e</sup>  
 afores<sup>d</sup> four hundred ~~acres~~ lying and being on y<sup>e</sup> west or  
 northwest part or end of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> 400 acres of Land the other  
 moiety on y<sup>e</sup> east or nose I have sold unto Thomas Perry  
 of the above County by a deed bearing this date may appear  
 to have and to hold the said bargained two hundred  
 acres of Land with all woods and water houses orchards  
 fences pastures therunto belonging or any waize appertaining  
 and all and other of y<sup>e</sup> premises with the apperlinencies with  
 all priviledges of fishing hunting Rauling and fowling  
 with all possib<sup>l</sup> comodities and liberties whatsoever unto  
 the said William Belk his heirs and assigns for ever  
 so long as y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Belk paying and discharging unto our sovereign  
 Lady y<sup>e</sup> Queen all such rents or shall hereafter be due for y<sup>e</sup>  
 said Land and also paying all taxes and Impositions
