In the Name of God Amen: this twenty Sixth of October 1716: I Anthony West
of the County of Accomack in Virginia being weak in body but sound in mind and memory
thank be to God for it: and I do make and ordain this my Last will and Testament for
myself and Bequeath as followeth

I Give and Bequeath unto my Son John West the one half of my Land insituate lying and
being on the south side of Handue Creek I mean that part and place which I now live be my Son
John West shall not let nor hinder my Son Anthony to get any timber off his part and for
one of my Son Anthony plantation but us further nor for any other use: and further I Give
and Bequeath unto my Son John West the one half of my part of said year plant to
him & his heirs for Ever: and further my will is that neither of my two Sons John and Anthony
shall sell any part of their Lands Except to each other with one & consent of each other I
mean forne shall not sell to any person without the free consent of his Brother and my
will is that my Land here on Handue Creek be equally divided between my two Sons John
West and Anthony West

I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Anthony West the one halfe of my Land insituate
lying and being on Handue Creek I mean that part lying on Mr. Peter Hock's plantation
formerly called Mr. Tarrerex Brown's plantation and further my Son Anthony shall not
nor hinder my Son John West getting any timber on this land for his Son John
plantation &c but us further nor for any other use and further more I give and bequeath
unto my Son Anthony West the on halfe of my part of said year plant to him and
his heirs for Ever: and further the true intent and meaning of my will is to be understood
that neither of my two Sons John and Anthony West shall any part or parcel of their
Land Except to each other with one & consent of each other I mean one shall not be
to any person without the free consent of his Brother and again my will is that in
land here on Handue Creek given by me to my above Son be equally divided both in
wood and on the Creek for every ones equal part

I Give and Bequeath unto my Son John West my pistol and holsters silver headed
long Gun and Bequeath unto my Son Anthony West my silver bell and a small Gun
I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Jane West a free privity on all my Lands above w^t
bound for Peter Hock his bath or Seat have of what kind soever with privity of house and
chimantance to long as she shall remaine unmarried

I Give and Bequeath unto my well beloved wife Elizabeth West al my slaves and
many he shall have liberty to build on that part of the Land before given him out
Estate amongst my children at her discretion and I do hereby appoint and constitute my wife
Elizabeth West whole Executrix of this my last will and Testament and I do for Ever last
disavow all other will and wills & agreements and Bequeaths what soever in writing except I have
justly and before signed & attested by me it is further my will and desire that the Anthony West
signed sealed & delivered } Court have not to pay any part or parcel
in the present of us } of my Estate

I give and bequeath unto my son Peter my Negro Jidley to him and his heirs
also I give and bequeath unto my daughter Ann Hack my Negro Jilly to called to the o. I
her heirs

Is also I give unto my three children George Peter and Ann all my silver money to be
laid out in a young negro girl to run in a joynt Stock between them
From I give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife all my hole Estate during her
widewdow but if my wife marries then my whole personal Estate to be equal
divid a monest my three children and my wife
and I earnestly desire and humbly request of my very good friend Mr. Hatt
that he will apointing my well beloved wife in her affaires which I may
be well

From I hereby constitute and appoint my well beloved wife to be my whole Executrix
of this my last will and testament revoking and hereby Disannulling all former
wills and testaments whatsoever by me formerly made and do publish and
declare this to be my last will and testament and in witness hereof
have set my hand and seal

the said Richard Kittson to the said Mary Bayly her heirs Executors Adm^t and Assignees forever a parcell of Land
containing one hundred acres situate lying and being in the County of Accomack
aforesaid near the head of Gargaphia branch beginning at a marked Gum in tan
nes branch thence running North west down the said branch one hundred and Sixty
poles unto a marked Pine thence South west by a line of marked trees unto Gargap
hia branch thence North west unto the fork of the said branch thence Southward
Eighty three degrees West by Fifty eight poles unto a corner marked Gum. Eastward
from Thomas Cappens land thence along the land of the said Cappens by marked trees
North west Sixty six poles unto a corner pine parting this from the land of the above
said Bayly thence North east one hundred and Twenty six poles along the to Bayly
land unto the place where it first began it being part of the offoresaid Richard
and Mary Kittsons fourteen hundred acres of land to have and to hold the said
one hundred acres of land with all houses orchards gardens fences with all wood
waters with privileges of fishing fowling and hunting with all profits Contra
cts and Priviledges whatsoever therunto belonging unto the said Mary
Bayly her heirs Executors Adm^t and Assignees Against the Claine of us that said
