I therefore give and bequeath all my personal Estate of what Nature & Condition soever unto my deare and loving Mother Bridget Custis sen^r. And do further appoint her my whole & sole Executrix of this my last and only Will & Testament. In witness whereof, I have subscribed my Hand and attested my Seal this twenty sixth Day of April In the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & twenty & two ——————
