Annoeck being sick & weak of Body but of a perfect mind & memory do make
and ordain this my last will & Testament in Manner & form as followeth
Imprimis I give and bequeath unto my son John Sread all my Land & plantation which I
Cought of major John Custis lying on Chincoteague to him & his heirs lawfully
begotten of his body male or female for ever
Item I give & bequeath unto my son Smith Sread all the Land & plantation
whereon John Dainger lives lying at Merry Branch to him and his heirs
forever.
Item I give ^{unto my black friend my negroes vizt)} Obadiah & Dinah
Item I give ~~unto~~ to my son Smith my Negroes (vizt) Sarah & Mington
Item I give to my loving wife Catherine Sread my Negroes (vizt) Jacob &
Betty during her natural life and after her Decease I give the aforesaid
Negroes. Jacob & Betty to my two sons John and Smith aforesnamed to be
equally divided between them.
And further my Will is that all my above given Negroes remaine in my
wifes Custody untill my son Smith arrive at the age of eighteen years
but in case my son Smith should not live to the age of eighteen years then
the above given Negroes to my sons John & Smith to be given to my son John
at the age of eighteen years but if my son Smith should live to the age of
eighteen years then do give and order that all the Increase of the above given
Negroes after my Decease be equally divided & given between my two
sons aforesnamed.
Item I give & bequeath all the remaining part of my Estate Real and personal
Goods & Chattels to be equally Divided between my wife & two Sons aforesnamed
and my will further is that if my two sons aforesnamed should Die without
Issue, I then give & bequeath unto my brother John Sread the Land and
Plantation whereon I now live, provided he binke in the ground where the
Graves are: -

Lastly I Do appoint my loving wife to be sole Executrix of this my last will & Testament and in Case of my wifes Death I do appoint Cap. Richard Drummond & William Wood to demand & receive all Debts due to me in favour of my Children.
