 my right & power of & to y^e within mentioned Ninety five Acres
 of Land and Premises and Covenant for my selfe that I my selfe
 and all others claiming in right shall & will for ever stand wholly
 Excluded and Debarred of any right or pretensions of right of Dower
 in y^e said Ninety five Acres of Land & Premises for ever by these
 p^resence In W^{it}ness whereof I have hereunto put my hand
 and Seal this 4th day of April In the year 1720

 Daniel Gore being Sick and weak of body but of sound and perfect
 Memory thanks be to y^e allmighty God Calling to Remenbrance y^e
 uncertaine State of this transitory life and that all flesh must yield
 unto Death when it shall please God to Call. Doe make ordaine &
 declare this my Last will & Testament in Manner & forme fol
 lowing To w^{it}ness and making void by these presents all and every
 will and Testam^t heretofore by me made or declared either in
 word or writing and this is to be taken for my Last will &
 Testam^t and none other first being penitent and sorry from
 the bottom of my heart for my sin^s past Most humbly Desire
 y^e forgiveness of the same I give and Comitt my Soul unto God
 y^e gave it me my Saviour and Redeemer in whose I trust. As
 surely to be saved & to have full pardon & Remission of all my
 sin^s & body to the earth to be buried wth Decent burrell at the
 direction of my Loving wife and now for the settling of my
 Temporall estate of such Land, Goody & Chattles as it hath pleas
 ed God farr above my defects to bestow upon me I doe Give order
 and dispose of y^e same in Manner and forme following first
 I will y^e all these Debt & Duty which I owe in right or conscience
 to any person wth never may be well & truly contented & paid
 by my ex^rcutrip Hereafter named
 first and bequeath unto my son William Gore two horses my
 saddle and bridle and two Mares my brandy still my pistols &
 Roasters and raiper my little gun my plate ring also fifteen
 pounds in Silver to purchase him a Silver Tankard and four
 silver two Boare & one Bull

Item: I Give unto my Son Selby Gore one horse four Cows two Steers one bullock
also eight pounds in gold and two Silver cups and two Silver Spoons one long Gun

Item: I Give and bequeath unto my Loving wife a horse Padle and Bridle

Item: I Give unto my two Daughters Joyce and Mary to each two gould Rings

Item: I Give unto my Son William Gore my Plantation I now dwell on with
my Neck of Land called great Neck to him his heirs and Assignes for ever
to be divided from Little Neck as after express

Item: I Give unto my Son Selby Gore the Plantation John Tuberville now
dwelling on with the Neck of Land called Little Neck to him his heirs and Assignes
for ever. But Whereas the two aforesaid Necks of Land is but one tract
as appears by Patent my will and Desire is that after three hundred
acres of the said tract is laid out in a square piece on the head
on the South west corner thereof that then the residue with the aforesaid
Necks to be equally divided between my two Sons aforesaid

Item: I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Joyce Gore the three hundred
acres of Land before mentioned to be laid out as aforesaid to her
and her heirs and Assignes for ever

Item: I Give unto my Daughter Mary Gore three hundred Acres of Land
lying in Maryland being the plantation and place on which Robert
Tindal now dwells to her heirs and Assignes for ever. It is also my
will and Desire if it either of my Daughters aforesaid should dye without
Issue that then her part should fall to the other her heirs & Assignes for ever

Item: I Give and bequeath unto my Son William Gore his heirs & Assignes
for ever two Necks of Land and marsh on Apataque Island called
Raged point and Little Neck as it is now Inclosed I also give unto my
Son William aforesaid one third part of five hundred Acres of Land
on the said Island bought of my Brother John Smith to his heirs
and Assignes for ever

Item: my will and Desire is if my Son William should have privilege
on the said Island aforesaid on the Land hereafter given unto my Son Selby
called great Neck to gett with Timber at bath Occasion off and
also for to fatten or keep four Steers yearly during his Natural life

Item: I Give and bequeath unto my Son Selby Gore his heirs and
Assignes for ever my Neck of Land on Apataque Island called Great
Neck as it is now Inclosed as for as the Divisionall line between
Virginia and Maryland and as for the Residue of my Land and Marsh
with on the beach between the Divisionall line aforesaid and
James Smiths Line I give unto my aforesaid two Sons William
and Selby Gore to be equally divided between them their heirs
and Assignes for ever

Item: I also Give and my Desire is that that all the Residue of
my Land and beach on the aforesaid Island below or to the South
ward of Thomas Smiths Land should be equally divided between
my two Sons aforesaid William and Selby Gore their
heirs and Assignes for ever

Item: I Give and bequeath unto my Loving Wife three Negroes as foth:
Betty, Hannah, and Ned

Item: I Give my Son William Gore four Negroes to witt Will. Mall. Tobey
and Phillip

Item: I Give unto my Son Selby Gore four Negroes - Fisher. Rose. Mingoe
and Pleasant

Item: I Give unto my Daughter Joyce Gore three Negroes - Genney:
Robert and Bess

Item: I Give unto my Daughter Mary Gore three Negroes - Nanney:
Dorcas and Park

And my Will and Desire is that all the Rest of my estate of what
kind or sort soever may be equally divided between my Loving
wife & my four Children afore named to each an Equall part thereof

I do hereby order and appoint that my two sons William & John
Gore be of age at eighteen years to receive their parts and
portions by this my will given them and my daughter Joyce
and Mary Gore at the age of fifteen years or day of Marriage
wh^{ch} shall first hapen to Receive their parts or portions hereby
Given them

Further my will and Desire is that if either or both my Daughters
afore^d should Receive their parts before they are married that if
my daughter Joyce should have privilege on the Land on the
Land Given my Son William to keep ten head of Cattle untill
she be married and also my daughter Mary to have the like
privilege of keeping ten head of Cattle on the Land given my
son Sally on y^e Land afore^d untill she be married

I do hereby appoint my loving wife Sole Executrix of this my
Last will and Testament and also appoint my trusty and
well beloved friends Mr. Edward Robins William Kelly and John
Purnell over-Seers or Trustees to see this my will duly performed
according to the true intent and meaning thereof, and in Confir-
mation hereof I have here unto put my hand and Seal and
pronounced the same my Last will and Testament

in y^e County of Ansonia being sick and weak of Body but of sound
Memory Giving praise to Almighty God for the same be all after his Marriage
and Blessing, Bestowed on me & considering wth my self the uncertain-
ty of y^e human life I do therefore make & appoint this to be my last
will & Testament Rescaking all other wills or wills by me formerly
made and first and principally I bequeath my soul to God the
Great Creator hoping & stedfastly believing through the mercy & b^{en}-
eficision of Jesus Christ to receive a full & free pardon for all my sins
and a place amongst the elect in y^e End of happiness & for what work
that the Lord in his Mercy hath bestowed on me I do order & be-
queath in manner following
I Give & bequeath to my son Scarborough Drumond two Good Beds & fur-
niture fitt for them one to have Curtains & valances the other not
also Give my son Scarborough twenty shillings. Item I Give & be-
queath to my son Richard Drumond my Plantation house live on Ind
and y^e half of half moon Island w^{ch} all y^e appurtenances thereunto
belonging to him & his heirs for ever halfe Give to my son Rich^d
four Negroes (viz) two named Dick Hagar & Rapney to him & his heirs for
ever only the first Child that the Negro Hagar shall bring that
shall live to y^e age of two years I Give & bequeath to my
Grandson Richard Drumond to him & his heirs lawfully begotten
of his body & my will is that if my son Grandson should dye without
such issue as afore^d that then I Give the y^e Child to my son Rich^d
& his heirs for ever halfe Give to my son Richard my mill & all
the appurtenances thereunto belonging & Item I Give & bequeath
to my Granddaughter Elizabeth Drumond my Negro Girl named Hunter to
her & her heirs lawfully begotten of her body but in case my afore^d
Granddaughter should dye without such issue that then I Give y^e
Girl to my Grandson Richard & his heirs lawfully begotten & in
