here after named as for my worldly Estate that it hath pleased God to appoint
on mee I dispose & order as followeth first I make void & null all former will
by mee made & ordaine this my last will & testament

Here I Give & Bequeath unto my Son Joseph Bentton a Pece of Land lying in Virginia
Between the Slewsh & the heare Line of my Land about my Plantation.
Item I Give & Bequeath a peccle of Land Lying in Somerset County in Maryland Beginning
on of West Side of my plantation on the Devition Line at a Small white Oake th
= red on South Side with two Natches running west & be North wth a Line of Mar
Trees already marked to W. James & all my land Lying in Maryland on & E
- terdide of that line unto my Son Joseph Bentton & his heirs for ever & if
Son Joseph Should dye without Issue then of above mention Land lying in Mary
land & in all her Heire in Virginia unto my Son Joshua & his heirs for ever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my Son Jonathan Brewton all & Part of my Land both
in Virginia & in Maryland that is not already Given unto him & his heirs for
ever & I give & bequeath to my Son Joseph a Gun that he doth Comonly use a
Barbers Horse — Item I give my Son Jonathan & Long Barrell of a Gun
& also my large Grindstone if it is in being at my wife Marriages or
I shall die before her — Item I give my Son Jonathan a Musket Gun

Relief & maintenance during her widowhood &
wife Judith should marry then what Estate of mine that is left shall be
divided between my wife & children - Item my will is that my wife
Eunice should have all w^t Benefit & provide for her widowhood in my howd
= strong plantation with provisoes to make up of any sum her or other matters for
plantations servs & there on to live during her widowhood w^t out any
disturbance or molestation what so ever & leaving what is here after men-
tioned - Item my will is a desire & I doe give unto my Son Joseph Bentson one
quarter of y^e Rider that shall be made out of my Orchard be helping to

Item my will is that my son Jonathan may seat on any part of W.P. and I have given him he not in w. least to disturb or disquiet his mother of any right or privilege in w. plantation during her widowhood wch I have already given - Lastly I appoint Constatte & Ordaine my loving wife Ruth Bentton Executrix & my Son Joseph Bentton Executor to be jointly Executors of this my last will & Testament in Confirmation that
is my last will Testament I have hereunto set my hand &
