Third I desire my body should be buried in a decent Christian like manner forthwith
I give unto my son Kendall Towels my now dwelling plantation beginning
at the line of partition Land you was born on — Part of Town lot off
Rabell Corbin & taking Length & Breadth proportionall as w^t land is off
given unto my son Kendall Towels unto the first gully by Branches w^t
the King & his full Aries lawfully begottin of his body for dear wife
my loving wife shall have it during her naturall life fifteene
— unto my son Tom Towels & my son Thomas Towels all the Romanes
part of my land from the gully or Branch before mentioned to be
part of my land betweene them I give it to them & there Lawfull
Equall division betwix them I give it to my son Thomas Towels
of my Lawfull begottion of this body for ever single & give unto my
son Thomas Towels one shilling severall I give unto my son Stockle
Towels one shillling severall I give unto my loving wife all the Romanes
natural life & after her decess I give it to my son Thomas Towels —
lastly I make my loving friends and neibours Thomas Jenkins & Thomas
Jenkins Junior my two executors of my estate & to see my will fullfilled
this I doe & doe acknowledge as my Reell act & deed of my last will
& Testament with my hand & seal this 17 day of January 1720
