 Accomack the recite where I doe hereby acknowledge doe alyan grant bargain sell and deliver
 unto him the peter Cornelius and to his heirs or assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel
 of land containing five hundred acres lying and being at the head of Kuntin Creek in this
 County of Accomack which said land was granted by patent to my father Arthur frame late
 of this county dec: and he dying intestate the said land reassured to me I being his only son
 which land is bounded on the northward and eastward by the lines of Surmairs mark
 trees which divide it from Thomas Simons land and on the southward and west ward
 side by lines of marked trees which divide between the said land and William Willet and
 John Melson and Charles White which said land being thus bounded limited and distinguished
 as it is agreed with al the wood waters property what what for ever there unto belonag-
 -ing or any way appurtenant together with al my Right title and justest claime or
 demand what soever I may might or could have thereunto is to him the said peter
 Cornelius and his heirs or assigns by me on spected to have and to hold the said land
 with the appurtenances for ever in as full and ample manner to al intents
 and purposes as by any Right or claime what soever I may mite or could occupy
 hold or posses the same and I the said Major frame and my heirs the said
 Land and premises with appurtenances unto him the said peter Cornelius and
 to his heirs or assigns for ever againe me or my heirs or any parson or par-
 -sons what so ever claiming from by or under me wil warrant and for ever defend
 by they presone and for the true performane of the same I have leave

 being being full in body but of loved mind & memory sheweth that I have unto
 God therefore I doe make & ordain this my Last will & Testament in manner
 following first & principally I Comend my soul into the hands of Almighty
 God that gave it, hoping in his Mercy throth the merits of my only Redeemer
 Jesus Christ I shall obtaine Eternal life and my Body I comitt unto the Earth with
 Resurrection of the Great Day of our Lord And as for such worldly & temporal Estate
 wherewith it hath pleased almighty God to bless me I dispose of the same in manner
 & form following
 I Give & bequeath my Dwelling Plantation unto my son Elias Hewitt always
 retaining a third part thereof unto my loving wife Elisha Hewitt & my will is
 my said son Elias in Consideration of the said Request do & shall when he
 arrives to the age of Eighteen pay unto each of his four sisters Elizabeth Tabitha
 Hannah and Sarah one thousand pounds of Tobacco each and all the rest of
 my Estate I Give and bequeath unto my loving wife for her benefit & of
 children wherewith that pleased God to bless me or may hereafter issue
 from my said wife as posthumous so as she may & shall enjoy the same
 during her remaining my widow but in case she marry then an Equal Divi-
 -sion of my personall Estate to be made in three day time after her Mar-
 -riage unto my next husband among all my children
 Item I do hereby nominate ordain & constitute my loving wife Elisha Hewitt a-
 -foresaid my sole executrix of this my Last will & Testament As Witness my
 hand & Seale the day & Year above mentioned
