 and two small basins won deep Dish won Beaver Hat all to be
 give to William & David James fifty yds of Lining Equally to be
 divided between them. Item I give to my Daughter in Law
 Sarah Doole the next best bed I have & furniture to it also won
 pillow won Cutch won small table won large Chest & two small
 dishes won Chamber pot I give to my Daughter Sarah
 & won blankets & won sheater

I give to William Spiers won Bed & cover of Blankets & won Sheatons
 two pillows & got left after that I leave them I give to Jackoby
 I give to Luke Spiers my horse and saddle - Item I give to Sarah
 Spiers won small Role of fine Lining also four neck porgors and
 three plates all the rest of my goods not before given my will it shall
 be my daughter in law Sarah Boles after my Just debts & funeral charges
